

10. Facilities for Practicals/Research

- Details of facilities to carry out theory and practical classes for UG students as per the recommendations of Medical Council of India :

1. One AC Lecture Hall of 200 seating capacity provided with a large black board, a white screen and a ceiling mounted LCD projector.
2. Two Demonstration Halls each with 75 seating capacity, black board and OH projector for conducting Tutorial classes as well as practical instructions and demonstrations.
3. Haematology and Amphibian Laboratories each with 50 seats capacity and a black board. One clinical physiology laboratory with 10 couches. All necessary laboratory equipment is available in sufficient number in working condition.

- Details of facilities to carry out additional classes and practicals at PG Level :

1. Amphibian Laboratory :

Electrically operated table top kymographs with accessory equipment to study frog's muscle-nerve preparation and live heart both in situ and isolated.

Two qualified laboratory technicians are present in the department, one with 14 years' experience in physiology laboratories.
