**1. Consideration of 09 Cases of Tehelka / CBI - reg.**

As per instructions of Chairman BOG's Dr. R.K. Srivastava on 05.06.2013 in reference to Tehelka matter, for compiling the sequences / Chronology of events for all these colleges to be placed before Dr. K.S. Sharma, Member - Board of Governors by Dr. Reena Nayyar, Deputy Secretary - UG Section. The chronology of events were seen and it was noted that in case of Rama Medical College, Gaziabad wherein surprise inspection was conducted by vigilance division, the surprise inspection noting, basis of surprise inspection (complaints) and relevant documents, & concerned file are not available / traceable. It was decided to present this entire matter before the Hon'ble Chairman in the ensuing BOG meeting after his return. It was also noted that the decision of Hon'ble Court to provide hearing to the Rama Medical College, Gaziabad. The hearing has been given by Hon'ble Board of Governors on 29.05.2013, wherein college authorities have submitted the compliance and requested for regular inspection. In between, Dr. Reena placed the letter dated 03.06.2013 from the Central Govt., Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, in reference to Council's letter dated 21.05.2013, for review.

It was also noted that of these 09 cases, only 06 cases pertain to tehelka matter and it was decided to consider the other 03 separately.
