5. Hard copies of journals are insufficient(there are only 1 Indian & 2 Foreign Journals).
6. Area of Central Lab. is around 25 sq. mtrs. This is insufficient to carry out investigations of all the 3 departments. i.e. Pathology, Microbiology and Biochemistry.
7. Blood Bank license is available up to 2000. License is not issued by the drug controller after 2000.
8. There is no separate PG hostel. They have earmarked one wing each of the UG hostel for PG in both boys and girls hostel.
9. Autopsy block is shared with Forensic Medicine. But no clinical autopsies are conducted.
10. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

Non -Medical Teachers are more than 50%.

2. Daily OPD attendance is : 842 and Bed Occupancy is 84%. These high OPD and bed occupancy do not commensurate with other clinical data like CT Scan, Microbiological investigations and histopathology (major surgeries -15). Data reported by Medical Superintendent.
3. Bed occupancy was 81.30% at 5.00 pm as reported by the Medical Superintendent. The Inspectors Team took the round of all the wards at 7.00 pm and observed that the overall bed occupancy in all wards was 57%.
4. Casualty attendance, major surgeries, minor surgeries, microbiology investigations and parasitology investigations do not commensurate with OPD attendance and bed occupancy.
5. Total number of Journals subscribed are 17 Indian and 13 Foreign as against the requirements 70 Indian and 30 Foreign. Meddler facility is not available.
6. Auditorium is not available.
7. Examination hall is not available.

8. Common room for 50 boys in basement of the college building without toilets and for 50 girls it is on ground floor without toilet.
 9. Hostel accommodation available for undergraduate boys is 200 and girls 250. Total accommodation available is 450 as against the requirement of 500.
 10. The hostel for Interns Residents & Nurses are not available.
 11. There are 4 lecture theaters in the college, 2 are gallery type and, 2 are level type, which is not as per norms.
 12. All OPD registrations are done manually with the help of 6 clerks. Waiting area is inadequate. Teaching facilities like x-ray view box, examination tray are not provided in all rooms. There are only two teaching areas each having capacity for 25-30. These teaching areas are shared by various departments.
 13. In many wards side laboratories not functional. Wards are congested, the space between the beds is not sufficient. Beds are numbered but unit wise distribution of the bed is not seen. Patients of dermatology and psychiatry are kept in the medicine ward which is not allowed.
 14. There is a medical record section located in a old heritage hut. There is no medical record officer. A MBBS doctor is performing the show. There is a computer but the record is not computerized. ICD X WHO classification is not followed.
 15. Total 15 beds are available in two rooms of casualty area, one room is having 7 beds with central oxygen supply. Both the rooms are without central suction, another room is not having central oxygen supply.
 16. Separate ICCU, Surgical ICU, Burns ICU, Pediatric ICU, Respiratory ICU are not available.
 17. Two static units of 300 mA are available as the against the requirement of 1-800 mA, 1-500 mA and 1-300 mA in the department of Radio-diagnosis.
 18. Service of the dietician is not available. There is no provision to supply therapeutic diet.
 19. Para Medical Staff: The specific technical paramedical staff is not provided.
 20. Residential Quarters – Total 12 quarters are available for teaching faculty, which is inadequate against the requirement of 60 at this stage.
 21. Anatomy Department : Toilet for staff members is inadequate. 36 students lockers are available, which is inadequate against the requirement for 100. Research Laboratory is not available. Deficiencies remain as it is.
 22. Pharmacology Department: Toilet for staff members is inadequate. Research Laboratory is not available. Deficiencies remain as it is.
 23. Physiology Department: toilet for staff members is inadequate. Research Laboratory is not available. Deficiencies remain as it is.
 24. Pathology Department: Research Laboratory is not available. Space and toilet for staff members is inadequate. Deficiencies remain as it is.
 25. Microbiology Department: Space and toilet for staff members is inadequate. Deficiencies remain as it is.
 26. Forensic Medicine Department: Space and toilet for staff members is inadequate. Deficiencies remain as it is.

Act,1956 restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students in MD(Psychiatry) & 2(two) students in DPM per year prospectively i.e. from the academic year 2009-10 commensurate with the number of teaching units and postgraduate teachers.
