**05. Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho at Alluri Sitaram Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Alluri Sitaram Raju Academy of Medical Science, Eluru for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) & D. Ortho. under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) & D. Ortho. courses at Alluri Sitaram Raju Academy of Medical Science, Eluru under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Alluri Sitaram Raju Academy of Medical Science, Eluru under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(One) to 2(Two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**07. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) & D.A. at MNR Medical College & Hospital, Sangareddy u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at MNR Medical College & Hospital, Sangareddy for increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) & D.A under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) & D.A courses at MNR Medical College & Hospital, Sangareddy under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada because of the following reason:-

1. Dr. Bala Subramanyam K, Dr. Magare Anwara Ranesh & Dr. N.Vasudeva Rao, Senior Residents, are appointed as Senior Resident with only 2 years, 1 year & 2 years experience respectively as Resident; hence not eligible.
2. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is deficient by 4 Senior Residents.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(Anaesthesia) & D.A courses from the academic session 2010-2011.

**08. Starting of MD(Pathology) at MNR Medical College & Hospital, Sangareddy, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at MNR Medical College & Hospital, Sangareddy for starting of MD(Pathology) under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Pathology) course at MNR Medical College & Hospital, Sangareddy under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the

number of admission to 1(One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**09. Starting of MD(Physiology) at Government Medical College, Thrissur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Government Medical College, Thrissur for starting of MD(Physiology) under Calicut University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Physiology) course at Government Medical College, Thrissur under Calicut University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**10. Starting of MD (Pharmacology) at Government Medical College, Thrissur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Government Medical College, Thrissur for starting of MD(Pharmacology) under Calicut University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Pharmacology) course at Government Medical College, Thrissur under Calicut University because of the followings:-

- (i) Dr. Ajitha K.N., Prof. & HOD and Dr. M.B. Sujatha, Assistant Professor, do not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**11. Starting of MD(Anatomy) at Government Medical College, Thrissur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Government Medical College, Thrissur for starting of MD (Anatomy) under Calicut University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Anatomy) course at Government Medical College, Thrissur under Calicut University because of the followings:-

- (i) Dr. Raju Jacob, Prof. & HOD and Dr. Sheela B., Associate Professor, do not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
- (iii) Mortuary coolers can hold only 2 bodies, which is inadequate.
- (iv) Illumination facilities in Histology laboratory inadequate.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**12. Starting of D.P.M. at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi for starting of D.P.M. under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of D.P.M. course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam because of the followings:-

- (1) Promotion of Dr. K.Sreekumar, Prof. & Head, is not as per MCI norms, as he has been promoted as Professor with the experience of only 1 year as Associate Professor against the requirement of 4 years as per Regulations.
- (2) Promotion of Dr. Chitra Venkateswaran, Associate Professor, is not as per MCI norms, as she has been promoted as Associate Professor with the experience only 1 year as Assistant Professor against the requirement of 5 years as per Regulations.
- (3) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
- (4) Average daily OPD is 30, which is inadequate.
- (5) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**13. Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) at Padamshree Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Padamshree Dr. D.Y.Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai under Dr. D.Y.Patil University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(One) to 2(Two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**14. Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) & D. Ortho. at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) & D. Ortho. under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. courses at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from

2(Two) to 5(Five) students in MS(Orthopaedics) & 2(Two) to 3(Three) students in D.Ortho. courses per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**15. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) & DCH at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) & DCH under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) & DCH courses at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 2(Two) to 4(Four) students in MD(Paediatrics) & 2(Two) to 3(Three) students in DCH courses per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**16. Starting of MD(Immuno Haematology and Blood Transfusion) at Seth G. S. Medical College, Mumbai, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai for Starting of MD(Immuno Haematology and Blood Transfusion) under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Immuno Haematology and Blood Transfusion) course at Seth G.S. Medical College, Mumbai under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the following reasons :-

1. Dr. Geeta S. Paranjape is visiting faculty; hence cannot be considered.
2. There is no Tutor/Sr.Resident in the Department.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**17. Starting of MD(Pathology) & DCP at Mahatama Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Aurangabad u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Mahatama Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Aurangabad for Starting of MD(Pathology) under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Pathology) & DCP courses at Mahatama Gandhi

Mission's Medical College, Aurangabad under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 3(Three) students in MD(Pathology) & 2(Two) students in DCP course per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**18. Starting of MS(ENT) at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad for Starting of MS(ENT) under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University, Karad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr. R.K.Karambelkar, Associate Professor & Dr. Vikas Sudhakar Kulkarni, Assistant Professor, do not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.

However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that the teaching faculty complement, other than the teachers mentioned above, is adequate and complete; and hence, decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MS(ENT) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University, Karad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 1(One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**19. Increase of seats in MD(Physiology) at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur for Increase of seats in MD(Physiology) under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr.(Mrs.) G.A. Kurhade, Professor of Physiology was absent on the day of inspection; hence she could not be considered.

However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that the teaching faculty complement, other than the teacher mentioned above, is adequate and complete; and hence, decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Physiology) course at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 2(Two) to 3(Three) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**20. Starting of MD(Anaesthesia) at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (August 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Kolkata for starting of MD(Anaesthesia) under the West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (August 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course at Vivekanand Institute of Medical Sciences, Kolkata under the West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata because of the following reason:-

1. There is no full time teaching faculty.
2. The institute is running DNB courses.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that an undertaking may be procured from the college authorities for stopping admission to DNB courses.

**21. Increase of seats in MD(Radiodiagnosis) at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur for Increase of seats in MD(Radiodiagnosis) under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Radiodiagnosis) course at Dr. S.N.Medical College, Jodhpur under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur because of the following reason:-

1. MRI is not yet installed.
2. Resultantly, instrumentation is inadequate.
3. There is deficiency of 4 Tutors/Senior Residents.
4. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(Radiodiagnosis) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**22. Increase of seats in MD(Biochemistry) at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar for Increase of seats in MD(Biochemistry) under Sri Devraraj Urs University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Biochemistry) course at Sri Devraj Urs Medical College, Kolar under Sri Devraraj Urs University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(One) to 2(Two) students



per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**23. Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) at Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr. Vinod Reddy, Assistant Professor, Unit-V, does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.

However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that the teaching faculty complement, other than the teacher mentioned above, is adequate and complete; and hence, decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 5(Five) to 6(Six) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**24. Starting/Increase of seat(s) in some PG Degree courses at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi, Meghe, Wardha - Consideration of the request for withdrawal of applications.**

Read: the letter dated 18/09/2009 received from the Registrar, Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences, Maharashtra requesting that the proposals may be considered for the next academic year i.e. 2011-2012.

- (i) There is inadequate surgical training material. Total of all surgical procedures by 6 units is 120/month (average) which is inadequate.
- (ii) The structured weekly/monthly teaching programmer is non-existing.
- (iii) Log books with PG students are not available.
- (iv) Total biopsy material was 909 for 9 months which is inadequate.
- (v) Imaging study such as special x-ray, ultrasound, CT scan and MRI are inadequate.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(General Surgery) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**48. Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) at J.J.M. Medical College, Davangere u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at JJM Medical College, Davangere for Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr. Manjunath BH, Reader, Unit-D, is not as per MCI norms; resultantly, teaching faculty component of Unit 'D' is incomplete.

The Postgraduate Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at JJM Medical College, Davangere under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, as the available clinical material is just adequate for present annual intake of 4(Four) students.

**49. Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) at J.J.M.Medical College, Davangere u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at JJM Medical College, Davangere for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that promotion of Dr. B. Ramappa, Assoc.Prof., is not as per MCI norms.

The Postgraduate Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at JJM Medical College, Davangere under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, as the available clinical material is just adequate for present annual intake of 8(Eight) students.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the number of D.A. seats prospectively shall be 6(Six) from the academic session 2010-11 commensurate with the available postgraduate teachers in the institute.

**50. Increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur for increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. courses under Sri Siddhartha University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. courses at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur under Sri Siddhartha University because of the followings:

- (1) Conventional/DSA Angiogram not available.
- (2) Radiological workload is low (plain x-rays 45-50/day, mammography 1/week).
- (3) Dr. N K Sridhar, Associate Professor, does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
- (4) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) and D.M.R.D. courses from the academic session 2010-2011.

**51. Increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) at Guahati Medical College, Guahati u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Guahati Medical College, Guahati for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course under Guahati University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Orthopaedics) course at Guahati Medical College, Guahati under Guahati University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 2(Two) to 5(Five) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**52. Increase of seats in MD(Psychiatry) at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak for Increase of seats in MD(Psychiatry) course under Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Psychiatry) course at Pt. B.D. Sharma Postgraduate Institute of Medical Sciences, Rohtak under Pt. B.D. Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak because of the followings:-

- (1) Unit I has only 2 teachers.
- (2) Promotion of Dr. Sujata Sethi, Professor & Incharge of Unit-II, is not as per MCI norms.
- (3) Dr. Rajeev Dogra, Assistant Professor, does not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- (4) Resultantly, teaching faculty component in both the units are incomplete.
- (5) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(Psychiatry) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**53. Starting of MD(Microbiology) course at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Surat u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Surat for starting of MD(Microbiology) course under Veer Narmad South Gujarat University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Microbiology) course at Surat Municipal Institute of Medical Education & Research, Surat under Veer Narmad South Gujarat University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the followings:-

- (i) The department is deficient by 1 Associate Professor.
- (ii) Dr. Asish Surana, Assistant Professor, does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**54. Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore for Increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 4(Four) to 8(Eight) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**55. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka because of the followings:-

- (i) Double records are maintained - manually and computerized. Computerized records of OPD & IPD numbers do not match the manual records provided by the college in SIF.
- (ii) Average daily OPD is 50. Average daily operative workload is 1-2 (Major); 3-4(Minor) only. Clinical material is inadequate.
- (iii) Existing staff members themselves are operating infrequently. Surgical Residents are not doing adequate operative work.
- (iv) Unit registers do not match central OT registers.
- (v) Speciality clinics are part of general OPD. No separate data are maintained.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(General Surgery) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**56. Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi, Meghe, Wardha, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences University, Maharashtra for increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) Course under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences University, Maharashtra u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr. Abhay M Gaindhane, Associate Professor, is not as per MCI norms. However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that the teaching faculty complement, other than the teacher mentioned above, is adequate and complete.

The Postgraduate Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences University, Maharashtra under Datta Meghe Institute of Medical Sciences University, Maharashtra commensurate with available postgraduate teachers.

**57. Starting of MS(O.B.G)& D.G.O courses at Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, A.P. u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the compliance verification inspection report (September 2009) along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences

& Research Foundation, Krishna Distt. under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for starting of MS(Obst. & Gynae.) & D.G.O. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (September 2009) along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MS(Obst. & Gynae.) & D.G.O. courses at Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Krishna Distt. under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 3(Three) students in MS(Obst. & Gynae.) & 2(Two) students in DGO course per year commensurate with available postgraduate teachers, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**58. Starting of MS(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses at Chalmeda Anandrao Institute of Medical Sciences A.P. u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the compliance verification inspection report (September 2009) along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Chalmeda Anandrao Institute of medical Sciences, Karimnagar under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for starting of MS(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (September 2009) along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MS(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses at Chalmeda Anandrao Institute of medical Sciences, Karimnagar under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 1(One) student in MS(Ophthalmology) & 1(One) student in D.O. per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**59. Starting of MD(Radiotherapy) at Dr. SN Medical College, Jodhpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Dr. SN Medical College, Jodhpur for starting of MD(Radiotherapy) course under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Radiotherapy) course at Dr. SN Medical College, Jodhpur under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences because of the followings:-

- (i) Equipment for Radio Surgery and intra operative Radiotherapy is not available.
- (ii) Facility for casting individualized shielding blocks is not available.
- (iii) HDR Brachytherapy unit, TPS, C-arm & USG are under commission.
- (iv) Facility for diagnostic/therapeutic radioactive isotope work is not available.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**60. Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur because of the followings:-

- (i) Unit-II, has only 2 teaching faculty members. Resultantly, teaching faculty complement is inadequate in Unit-II.
- (ii) Equipment like B-Scan and facilities for Retinal Laser are not available.
- (iii) Facilities for Retinal repairs are not available.
- (iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(Ophthalmology) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**61. Starting of MS(E.N.T) course at Mahatma Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Mahatma Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Navi Mumbai for starting of MS(E.N.T) course under MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MS(E.N.T) course at Mahatma Gandhi Mission's Medical College, Navi Mumbai under MGM University of Health Sciences, Navi Mumbai because of the followings:-

- (i) Unit-I has only 20 beds against requirement of 30 beds.
- (ii) Average daily OPD is 30-40/day. Average daily operative workload is 1-2/day. Data from 1-15 September show that only 9 operations (6 Major & 9 Minor) were performed in this period. Resultantly, clinical material is inadequate.
- (iii) Equipment like impedance audiometer, BERA facility, fiberoptic endoscopy are not available.
- (iv) There is no full time Audiologist or Speech Therapist.
- (v) Dr. Rashmi Menon, Assistant Professor, does not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**62. Starting of Diploma in Orthopaedics at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi for starting of Diploma in Orthopaedics course under Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of Diploma in Orthopaedics course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**63. D.Y.Patil University, Kolhapur - Recognition of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification in respect of students being trained at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Kolhapur.**

Read: the compliance verification report (September, 2009) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (May,2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Kolhapur for purpose of recognition of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by D.Y.Patil University, Kolhapur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (September, 2009) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (May, 2009) and decided to recommend that M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by D.Y.Patil University, Kolhapur in respect of students being trained at D.Y.Patil Medical College, Kolhapur be recognized and included in the 1<sup>st</sup> Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 3(Three) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

".....

6.4 *The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

6.6 *Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.*

....."

**64. Withdrawal of applications submitted for increase in intake capacity of MS/MD courses at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Pimpri, Pune.**

Patil Medical College, Pimpri, Pune for withdrawal of proposal for increase of seats in various PG courses and decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the scheme for increase of seats in (1) MD(TB & Chest), (2) MD(Radio-Diag.), (3) MS(ENT), (4) MD(Psychiatry), (5)MD(Anaesthesia), (6) MS(Ophthalmology), (7) MD(Skin & V.D.), (8) MS(General Surgery), (9) MS(Ortho.), (10) MD(General Medicine), (11) MD(Paediatrics), (12) MD(Obst. & Gynae.) courses at Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Pimpri, Pune u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as there is no provision u/s 10A of the



Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

**65. Starting of MD(Biochemistry) at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital, Ludhiana u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital for Starting of MD(Biochemistry) course under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Biochemistry) course at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot because of the followings:-

- (i) Dr. A.P.S. Narang, Professor, Dr. Renuka Sood, Professor, Dr. Satinder Kaur, Associate Professor, & Dr. Indu Verma, Associate Professor, do not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is deficient by 1 Assistant Professor.
- (iii) Equipments in the laboratory are on loan basis which are maintained by respective companies. Only kits are purchased.
- (iv) No documentary proof of quality control programme on laboratory accreditation was provided.
- (v) Research laboratory is in a small room with few instruments. Electrophoresis was not functional. There is no spectrophotometers or ELISA Reader.
- (vi) No documentary proof of biomedical waste disposal was provided.
- (vii) There is no departmental museum.
- (viii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**66. Starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) at Government Medical College, Nagpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Government Medical College, Nagpur for Starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Government Medical College, Nagpur under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 1(One) student per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**67. Starting of MD(Geriatrics) at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi for Starting of MD(Geriatrics) course under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Geriatrics) course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam because of the followings:-

- (i) Promotion of Dr. K.K. Velayudhan, Professor & HoD, is not as per MCI norms, as he has been promoted to the post of Professor with experience of only 11 months as Associate Professor.
- (ii) Dr. George Paul, Assistant Professor, does not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- (iii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.
- (iv) Average daily OPD is 30-35, which is inadequate.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**68. Increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for increase of seats in MS(Pharmacology) course under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(Pharmacology) course at Padamshree Dr. D.Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai under Dr. D.Y. Patil University because of the followings:-

1. Dr. Manish Hathial, Associate Professor, failed to show PAN Card. As no TDS was deducted form the salary, he was asked to show the pay slip which was not produced.
2. Dr. Pramila Yadav, Associate Prof. failed to submit relieving order from the previous institute.
3. Though Pharmaceutical Chemist & Veterinary Doctor were present on the day of inspection, the authorities failed to produce their pay slip or any other relevant record.
4. Clinical Pharmacology laboratory is in very primitive stage. It needs to be upgraded.
5. New research equipment is not available in the department.
6. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(Pharmacology) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**69. Increase of seats in MS(ENT) at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur for increase of seats in MS(ENT) course under Sri Siddhartha University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(ENT) course at Sri Siddhartha Medical College, Tumkur under Sri Siddhartha University, commensurate with available postgraduate teachers.

**70. Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) at Adichuunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Bellur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Adichuunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Bellur for Increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at Adichuunchanagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Bellur under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(One) to 2(Two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**71. Increase of seats in MD(OBG) at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karmsad u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karmsad for Increase of seats in MD(OBG) course under Sardar Patel University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(OBG) course at Pramukhswami Medical College, Karmsad under Sardar Patel University, as the available infrastructure, teaching facilities and research activities are just adequate for present intake of 2(Two) Degree & 2(Two) Diploma per year.

**72. Starting of MD(Pulmonary Medicine) at Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur for Starting of MD(Pulmonary Medicine) course under Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Pulmonary Medicine) course at Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur under Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**73. Increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) at JJM Medical College, Davangere u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at JJM Medical College, Davangere for Increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Pharmacology) course at JJM Medical College, Davangere under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 4(Four) to 6(Six) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**74. Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore for Increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr. Prithi Jain, Associate Professor & Dr. Shailaja S, Assistant Professor, do not possess recognized postgraduate qualification. However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that even without the teachers mentioned above, the teaching faculty component is adequate and complete.

The Postgraduate Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Anaesthesia) course at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Karnataka, commensurate with available postgraduate teachers.

**75. Starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad for Starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University, Karad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University, Karad because of the followings:-

- (i) Average daily OPD is 55, which is inadequate.
- (ii) Equipment like dark ground microscope is not available.
- (iii) Special clinics like STD Clinic, Dermatitis Clinic, etc. are not available.
- (iv) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

**76. Starting of various PG Degree courses at Khaja Bandanawaz Institute of Medical Sciences- Consideration of the request for withdrawal of applications.**

Read: the letter dated nil received from the Principal, Khaja Bandanawaz Institute of Medical Sciences with regard to withdrawal of proposal for Starting of various Postgraduate courses.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated nil received from the Principal, Khaja Bandanawaz Institute of Medical Sciences with regard to withdrawal of proposal for Starting of various Postgraduate courses and decided to return the application/scheme to the Central Govt. for starting new PG Degree courses at Khaja Bandanawaz Institute of Medical Sciences u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as there is no provision u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

**Office Note:** The Postgraduate Committee decided that in future in such cases where the institute has applied for withdrawal of application for postgraduate courses, such applications may be returned by the office directly to the Central Govt. and Postgraduate Committee may be informed about the same in its next meeting.

**77. Increase of seats in MS(OBG) at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College, Pune u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College, Pune for increase of seats in MS(OBG) course under Bharati Vidyapeeth University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MS(OBG) course at Bharati Vidyapeeth Medical College, Pune under Bharati Vidyapeeth University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 4(Four) to 5(Five) students per year commensurate with available postgraduate teachers, till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

**78. Increase of Seats in MS (General Surgery) at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital, Ludhiana u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.**

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital for Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Dayanand Medical College & Hospital under Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot because of the followings:-

- (i) Average daily OPD 26-61/day.

- (ii) Average daily bed occupancy rate – 56%.
- (iii) No special clinics except bariatric surgery is available.
- (iv) Resultantly, clinical material is inadequate.
- (v) There is no ward side lab.
- (vi) There is no facility for frozen section biopsy.
- (vii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(General Surgery) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**79. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada – Approval of Narayana Medical College, Nellore for the award of MD (Anatomy) qualification.**

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Narayana Medical College, Nellore for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD(Anatomy) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (June, 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 18.07.2009 not to approve Narayana Medical College, Nellore for the award of MD(Anatomy) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada as the compliance is unsatisfactory because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Promotion of Dr. Arun Kumar S. Bilodi, Professor, is not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.

The Committee further decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 18.07.2009 to direct the institution authorities to stop admission in MD(Anatomy) course for the existing intake from the academic session 2010-11.

**80. Bundelkhand University – Recognition of M.D. (Pharmacology) qualification in respect of students being trained at M.L.B. Medical College, Jhansi.**

Read: the Council inspector report (August, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at M.L.B. Medical College, Jhansi for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification granted by Bundelkhand University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (August, 2009) and decided not to recognize M.D.(Pharmacology) qualification granted by Bundelkhand University in respect of students being trained at M.L.B. Medical College, Jhansi because of the followings:-

- (i) The department is deficient by 1 Associate Professor.
- (ii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee also noted that the members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council, while considering the Inspectors report (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Aug., 2008) had decided as under:-

"The members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council considered the Council Inspectors report (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Aug., 2008) and noted the following:-

1.(a) The shortage of teaching faculty is 51.6% (i.e. 65 out of 126) as under:-

- The Radiology & laboratory workload is very low.

3. Space for teaching area is not available in any of the OPDs.
4. Operation Theatres - TV with camera attachment is not available. Resuscitation and monitoring equipment is shared by the different O.T.s. There is no post operative ward.
5. There is no Paediatric ICU.
6. There is no MRI or CT Scan.
7. There is no CSSD, Mechanised laundry, Canteen and EPABX.
8. There is no incinerator available. There is no provision/ agreement with any organization for the disposal of the hospital bio-medical waste. The hospital bio medical waste is dumped in a pit.

9. *The availability of para medical staff of different categories is inadequate for the present stage as under:-*

10. *There is no lecture theatre in the hospital. Clinical demonstration rooms are not available in OPD.*
11. *Hostels: All the hostels are in a dilapidated condition. There is no maintenance of the hostel building. The drains around the hostel are clogged and are stinking. There is seepage in the hostel rooms. The doors and windows are broken. The toilets and washrooms are dirty and have not been cleaned. The furniture is old and broken. Concrete slabs have been used as table and stools in the mess which are not clean. This makes the mess shabby and unhygienic. There is no class iv staff posted in the hostel.*
12. *Other deficiencies/remarks pointed out in the inspection report.*

*In view of above, the members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council decided to issue a show cause notice to the authorities of M.L.B. Medical College, Jhansi as to why the recognition for the award of MBBS degree should not be withdrawn u/s 19 of the IMC Act,1956 and further decided to advise the institute to respond to the show cause notice within two months on receipt of the communication. Copy of the letter be also marked to DME of the concerned State Govt., Registrar of the University to which the college is affiliated and also to the member of MCI representing the State where the college is located".*

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in M.D.(Pharmacology) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

**81. Frequent Movement of Teaching Faculty across the medical college in the Country.**

Read: the matter with regard to Frequent Movement of Teaching Faculty across the medical colleges in the Country.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to frequent movement of teaching faculty across the medical colleges in the Country and noted that the frequent movement of faculty members during the same academic year has been observed to be quite common. There are instances where a faculty member has left an institution within days of joining after the inspection is over. On several occasions while deliberating upon the inspection report of different institutes for permission/recognition of various postgraduate courses, it has been noticed that there is a frequent movement of the faculty members irrespective of their seniority from one institute to another during the same academic year; more so during the MCI inspection for the purpose of starting/increase of seats/recognition of postgraduate courses and thereby causing considerable disruption of teaching activities and training programme, which is very vital for postgraduate medical education.

The members of the Postgraduate Committee observed that such a practice would also lead to deterioration of quality of medical education. It was further observed that unless the practice of frequent movement of the teaching faculty is curbed, the standard of postgraduate medical education in the country will definitely have a serious impact. The Committee also felt that it is always desirable if the transfer/posting of a postgraduate medical teacher is not done during the middle of an academic session.



After due deliberations, with a view to curb the unhealthy practice of frequent movement of teaching faculty and to inculcate a sense of commitment amongst the members of the teaching faculty and also in the best interest of the medical education and patient care, the Postgraduate Committee decided that no teacher should be considered as a faculty member in any other institute during the period till the postgraduate course at the institute which has been granted permission considering him as a member of teaching faculty is recognized.

**82. Jiwaji University - Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) & D.Ortho. qualification in respect of students being trained at G.R. Medical College, Gwalior.**

Read: the Council inspector report (October 2009) on the teaching and other infrastructure facilities available at G. R. Medical College, Gwalior carried out in compliance of the order pass by the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh for recognition of MS(Ortho) and D(Ortho) qualifications granted by Jiwaji University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council inspector report (October 2009) and decided not to recognize MS(Ortho) and D(Ortho) qualifications granted by Jiwaji University in respect of students being trained at G. R. Medical College, Gwalior because of the followings:-

- (i) There are only 2 units in the department instead of 3 units required as per Regulations.
- (ii) Beds are not as per MCI norms.
- (iii) Daily OPD is 90/day, which is inadequate.
- (iv) Dr. R.K.S. Dhakad, Associate Professor, does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
- (v) Dr. G.S.Vyas already been considered as a postgraduate teacher in Medical College, Rewa; hence, he cannot be considered as a postgraduate teacher at G.R. Medical College, Gwalior in the current academic session.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The Postgraduate Committee also noted that the members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council at its meeting held on 02.12.2006, while considering the Inspectors report (24<sup>th</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2006) had decided as under:-

“.....

The compliance was verified by way of inspection on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> Nov., 2006. Perusal of this inspection report reveals the following deficiencies as under:-

1. The shortage of teaching faculty is as under:-

(a) Faculty 28.8%

Professor : 04 (Microbiology-1, TB & Chest -1, Medicine - 1, ENT -1)

Associate Professor: 28 (Anatomy -2, Physiology -1, Biochemistry- 1, Pathology -4, Microbiology -1, Pharmacology -3, FMT-2, Medicine -2, Psychiatry-1, Pediatrics -2, Surgery -4, Orthopaedics -1, Dental -1, Ophthalmology -2, Radiology -1)

Assistant Professor: 16 (Anatomy-3, Physiology-1, Biochemistry - 2, Pathology -1, Pharmacology -2, FMT-1, PSM- 1, Medicine -1, Surgery - 2, Radiodiagnosis - 2),

Tutor: 01(FMT -1)

(b) Resident 25.8%

(i) Sr. Resident: 20( TB & Chest – 1, Medicine-6, Pediatrics- 3, Surgery – 6, Orthopaedics-3, Ophthalmology- 1)

(ii) Jr. Resident: 08 (TB & Chest -2, Skin & VD – 3, Psychiatry-3)

2. Central oxygen, nitrous oxide & central suction in the operation theatres are not in working order.
3. Paramedical staff is inadequate is as under:-

5. The capacity of lecture theatre is not as per Council norms.
6. The accommodation in students' hostel is available only for 585 students against the requirement of 700 at this stage. There is only one combine hostel for interns, PGs and Residents with a capacity of 100 which is grossly inadequate.
7. In the central library, the number of journals subscribed are only 41 against the requirement of 100. The non-teaching staff in library is inadequate.
8. The capacity of examination hall is only 230, which is inadequate.
9. In the central animal house, Guinea pig, mice and large animals are not available. The veterinary officer and attendants are also not available.
10. RHTC, Dabra is under the control of Director Medical & Health Services, which is not as per norms.
11. The indoor registration counter is computerized but not cross linked with outdoor registration counter and of MRD computer.
12. The organizational and the operational part of both OPD and indoor laboratories is not proper. There are no adequate required automation instruments in any of the laboratories
13. The Biochemistry department is not involved in any diagnostic services neither in college nor in hospital. The anomalies in the working of various diagnostic units should be corrected and all the three departments i.e pathology, microbiology & biochemistry should be effectively involved in the library work.
14. Central laundry is not available.
15. In the infrastructure of 1<sup>st</sup> MBBS deptt., the following deficiencies are observed:-
  - a. Anatomy
    - There is no electric saw
    - There is no separate cooling cabinet available.
  - b. Physiology
    - The laboratory of human and mammalian experiments is not available.
  - c. Biochemistry
    - There is no demonstration room available.
    - Gas cylinders need to be kept away in a separate enclosures.
    - The department does not participates in hospital work.

In the infrastructure of para-clinical department, the following deficiencies are observed:

  - (a) Pharmacology
    - The clinical pharmacology and experimental pharmacology laboratory is not as per norms.
  - (b) Pathology
    - The capacity of demonstration room is not as per norms.

16. The institution does not have separate departments of Psychiatry, Skin & VD and TB & Chest. These specialties are divisions / section under the department of medicine which is not as per norms. These departments do not have their own teaching / demonstration rooms, side laboratories and libraries which is not as per norms.
17. The Professor of Skin & VD is the Head of department of medicine.
18. Other deficiencies / remarks are in the report.

The members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council also observed that the deficiencies in terms of teaching faculty and infrastructure have worsened and the quantum of the deficiencies is much higher than that observed in 2003 inspection.

In view of above, the members of the Adhoc Committee appointed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and of the Executive Committee of the Council decided to reiterate its decision taken at its meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2003 to recommend to the Central Govt. to withdraw the recognition of MBBS Degree in respect of G.R. Medical College, Gwalior granted by Jiwaji University, Gwalior as approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 20/10/2003 and recommended to the Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, (Department of Health), Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi vide letter dated 12.01.2004 for further necessary action u/s 19 of the IMC Act, 1956 and request the Central Government to direct the institute not to make any further admissions in the MBBS course w.e.f. academic year 2007-08.  
....."

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(Ortho) and D(Ortho) courses from the academic session 2010-2011.
