5. Only 3-4 whole blood units are cross matched daily & similar number of units are collected from donors at this blood bank daily on site. The facilities are just basic. Facilities of blood component are not available.
6. Space for departmental office is not available.
7. Resultantly, infrastructure is inadequate.
8. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

However, no communication regarding the inspection from the college.*" authorities institution authorities were reluctant to undergo inspection as reported by the Inspector.

6. Dr N S Pawar is not considered as SR, since he is working as Medical Superintendent.
7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of the Govt. of India letter dated 15.3.2005 issued after the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Mridul Dhar V/s UOI & Ors. requesting the Council to strictly adhere to the time schedule prescribed under the Regulations, and as per the Schedule prescribed in the opening of a New or Higher course of study or training (including postgraduate course of study or training and increase of admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), Regulations, 2000, the last date for sending the recommendations of the MCI for grant of Letter of Permission to the Central Govt. being 28th February, the Members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for starting of MD(Biochemistry) course at Rural Medical College, Ioni under Pravara Instt. of Medical Sciences (Deemed University) received u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

276 **Starting of MS (Ortho.) course at K.V.G. Medical College, Sullia under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.**

Read: the compliance verification report (Feb. 2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (Nov., 2008) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at K.V.G. Medical College, Sullia for starting of MS (Orthopaedics) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Feb., 2009) and noted the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

1. Patient's attendance in the Physio-therapy department are still less in number.
2. In the museum, there are only 8 specimens but none for Orthopaedics. Hence museum still requires upgradation.
3. Journals were not available in the library. The quality of books in the central library is very poor and only very basic books are kept there. In the departmental library very primitive books are kept. Only one Indian journal namely Indian Journal of Orthopaedics is in the departmental library and one issue of International journal was shown. Hence departmental library requires upgradation.
4. Instrumentation was inadequate as Arthroscope was not available and equipments in the Physiotherapy department are very old. Hence instrumentation requires upgradation.
5. Clinical material is inadequate.
6. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of the Govt. of India letter dated 15.3.2005 issued after the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Mridul Dhar V/s UOI & Ors. requesting the Council to strictly adhere to the time schedule prescribed under the Regulations, and as per the Schedule prescribed in the opening of a New or Higher course of study or training (including postgraduate course of study or training and increase of admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), Regulations, 2000, the last date for sending the recommendations of the MCI for grant of Letter of Permission to the Central Govt. being 28th February, the Members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for starting of MS(Orthopaedics) course at K.V.G. Medical College, Sullia under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

277 Mumbai University - Recognition of M.D.(General Medicine) qualifications in respect of students being trained at K.J. Somaiya Medical College & Research Centre, Mumbai.

Read: the Compliance Verification Report (February, 2009) together with the compliance and the Council Inspector's Report (July 2006) carried out to assess the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at K.J. Somaiya Medical College & Research Centre, Mumbai for purpose of recognition of M.D. (General Medicine) qualification granted by Mumbai University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Feb., 2009) and noted the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

1. Halter and evokepotentials are not available.
2. Resultantly, instrumentation is inadequate.
3. Unit III has got only 2 teachers and Unit IV has only 1 teacher.
4. Promotion of Dr.B.N.Sawant Head of Unit III is not as per MCI norms.
5. Resultantly, teaching complement is incomplete.
6. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of the Govt. of India letter dated 15.3.2005 issued after the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Mridul Dhar V/s UOI & Ors. requesting the Council to strictly adhere to the time schedule prescribed under the Regulations, and as per the Schedule prescribed in the opening of a New or Higher course of study or training (including postgraduate course of study or training and increase of admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), Regulations, 2000, the last date for sending the recommendations of the MCI for grant of Letter of Permission to the Central Govt. being 28th February, the Members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for starting of M.D. (General Medicine) course at K.J. Somaiya Medical College & Research Centre, Mumbai under Mumbai University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

278 Himachal Pradesh University - Recognition of MD (Pharmacology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla.

Read: the Council Inspector's Report (February, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla for purpose of recognition of MD (Pharmacology) qualification granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) and decided to recommend that MD (Pharmacology) qualification granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year.

279. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada - Restoration of seats in M.D. (Pathology) course at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad in respect of increased intake.

Read: the compliance verification report (February, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad for purpose of approval of the college for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (February, 2009) and noted that Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad already stands approved for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification with 7 (seven) seats and now the matter is under consideration for approval of the college against the increased intake from 7 (seven) to 12 (Twelve) seats; and decided to recommend that Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad be approved for the award of MD (Pathology) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of increased intake restricting the number of admissions to 12 (Twelve) students per year.

280. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at M.R. Medical College, Gulbarga under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (Oct, 2008) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at M.R. Medical College, Gulbarga under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences for increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at M.R. Medical College, Gulbarga under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2009-2010 restricting the number of admissions to 4(four) to 6(six) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

281. Starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) course at Prathima Institute of Medical Sciences, Karimnagar under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the matter with regard to starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) course at Prathima Institute of Medical Sciences, Karimnagar under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

The Postgraduate Committee in its meeting held on 31.1.2009 considered the proposal starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) course at Prathima Institute of Medical Sciences, Karimnagar under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and recommended to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD (Forensic Medicine) course because of the following reasons:-

1. Medico-legal work is not done.
2. Teaching faculty is deficient by 2 Asst. Profs.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

The above decision of the Committee was communicated to the Central Govt. with copy to the college authorities with the request to send compliance on rectification of the deficiencies latest by 09.02.2009. In reference to the above, the compliance has been received on 24.2.2009 i.e. beyond the stipulated period. Hence the same could not be verified by way of an inspection.

282. Discharge of PG students admission made for the academic year 2008-09.

Read: the letter dated 16/2/2009 regarding discharge of PG students admitted for the academic year 2008-2009.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 16/2/2009 regarding discharge of PG students admitted for the academic year 2008-2009 and decided that the legal opinion may be obtained from the Council Advocate.

283. Starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course at Command Hospital (WC), Chandimandir, Haryana affiliated to Kurukshetra University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance verification report (Feb.,2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (August, 2008) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Command Hospital (WC), Chandimandir, Haryana under Kurukshetra University for starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (August, 2008) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD(Anaesthesia) course at Command Hospital (WC), Chandimandir, Haryana under Kurukshetra University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2009-2010 restricting the number of admissions to 2(two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

- The Minutes of items pertaining to Section 10A were read out and confirmed in the meeting itself and the Office was directed to send the communications to the Central Government immediately within the time limit prescribed under the Regulations.
