05. Starting of MS(Orthopaedics) & Diploma in Orthopaedics courses at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at the Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram for starting of MS(Orthopaedics) & Diploma in Orthopaedics courses at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram under the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (January 2010) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MS(Orthopaedics) & Diploma in Orthopaedics courses Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram under the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 because of the followings:-

- (i) Promotion of Dr. Deepak Kumar Varma, Associate Professor of Unit-II, is not as per MCI norms.
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is inadequate.
- (iii) Facilities for occupational therapy (artificial limbs, braces, shoes) are not available.
- (iv) Investigative facilities like Nerve Conduction & EMG are not available.
- (v) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

06. Starting of MD(Pathology) course at Maharaja's Institute of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the information received from the various Government medical colleges / institutions with regard to number of Professors, No. of Units & bed strength in each Post Graduate Speciality together with the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Central Government Gazette notification dated 24/07/2009 regarding amendments in clause 12(1), (2), (3) & (4) of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations 2000 and noted the following:-

1. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course where diploma is not prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the degree per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit for broad specialities.
2. The ratio of recognized postgraduate teacher to the number of students to be admitted for the degree course in broad specialities where diploma is prescribed shall be 1:2 for a Professor and 1:1 for other cadres in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats including diploma per unit per academic year provided a complement of 10 teaching beds is added to the prescribed bed strength of 30 for the unit.
3. The requirement of units and beds shall not apply in the case of Postgraduate degree or diploma courses in Basic and para-clinical departments.

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

4. The ratio of PG teacher to the number of students to be admitted for super specialities course shall be 1:2 for Professor/Assoc. Professor and 1:1 for remaining cadre in each unit per year subject to a maximum of 4 PG seats for the course per unit per academic year provided the complement of 10 teaching beds per seat is added to the prescribed bed strength of 20 for the unit."

Provided that against the very same units, teaching personnel and infrastructure, no other postgraduate courses under any other streams like National Board of Examinations, College of Physicians & Surgeons etc. are permitted.

Accordingly a circular was sent by the Council Office to the Health Secretaries of all the states on 15/09/2009 and 24/09/2009 requesting to direct the Deans/Principals to send the information as regards availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialties and availability of Professors and Assoc Professors in respect of super specialties and also unit wise number of teaching beds and students.

University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956, as compliance is unsatisfactory, because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) Promotion of Dr.M.Anthony David Swaroop Kumar, Assoc. Prof. is not as per MCI norms, as he has been promoted as Professor with experience of only 1 year as Associate Professor against requirement of 4 years (as no fresh Govt. order is being enclosed).
- (ii) Resultantly, teaching faculty component is inadequate.
- (iii) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

93. Pondicherry University- Approval of Mahatma Gandhi Medical College,& Research Institute Puducherry for the award of D.C.H. qualification

Read: the compliance verification report (Jan., 2010) together with Council Inspector report (July 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Mahatma Gandhi Medical & Research Institute Puducherry for purpose of approval of the college for the award of DCH qualification granted by Pondicherry University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Jan., 2010) together with Council Inspector report (July 2009) and decided to recommend that Mahatma Gandhi Medical & Research Institute Puducherry be approved for the award of DCH qualification granted by Pondicherry University restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

6.4 *The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

97. Starting of MD(Pathology) course at Govt. Medical College, Kota, Rajasthan u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (November, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Kota for Starting of MD(Pathology) course under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (November, 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 15.12.2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Pathology) course at Govt. Medical College, Kota under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956, as compliance is unsatisfactory, because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

1. Promotion of Dr. H.L. Meena, Associate Professor, is not as per MCI norms as she has been promoted as Associate Professor with experience of only 2 years, 11 months and 25 days as Assistant Professor and Dr. Meena also does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
2. Dr. Rajshree Bhati, Assistant Professor, does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
3. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

98. Increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance verification report (Jan., 2010) together with the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facility available at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai for increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Jan., 2010) together with the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 09.10.2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(General Surgery) course at Padamshree Dr. D. Y. Patil Medical College, Navi Mumbai under Dr. D. Y. Patil University u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as compliance is unsatisfactory, because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

- (i) There is inadequate surgical training material. Total of all surgical procedures by 6 units is 120/month (average) which is inadequate.
- (ii) The structured weekly/monthly teaching programmer is non-existing.
- (iii) Log books with PG students are not available.
- (iv) Total biopsy material was 909 for 9 months which is inadequate.
- (v) Imaging study such as special x-ray, ultrasound, CT scan and MRI are inadequate.
- (vi) Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MS(General Surgery) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

Act, 1956, as there is no provision u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

100. Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, Faizabad.

Read: the letter dated 7/01/2010 received from the Central Govt. Ministry of Health & F.W. requesting to consider the proposal for increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow for the academic year 2010-2011.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (Jan., 2010) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Era Medical College, Lucknow for increase of seats in MD(OBG) and D.G.O. courses under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, U.P. u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Jan., 2010) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(OBG) course at Era Medical College, Lucknow under Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Avadh University, U.P. u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 2(Two) to 3(Three) students in MD(OBG) course per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Postgraduate Committee further considered the letter dated 8/1/2010 received from Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow for not to increase of seats in DGO course at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow and decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for increase of seats in DGO at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as there is no provision u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

102. Starting of Diploma in Orthopaedics course at B.J. Medical College, Pune u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Dec., 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of D.Ortho course at B.J. Medical College, Pune under Maharashtra University

of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(Two) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

103. Starting of M.D. (Psychiatry) course at R.N.T. Medical College, Udaipur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance verification report (Jan., 2010) together with the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at R. N. T. The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with Council Inspector's report (September, 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 15.12.2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Radiodiagnosis) course at Pt. J. N. M. Medical College, Raipur under Chhattisgarh Ayush and Health Sciences University u/s 10A of

the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as number of available postgraduate teachers commensurate with present annual intake of 1(One) Degree & 3(Three) Diploma seats.

106. Increase of seats in various Postgraduate courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow - regarding.

Read: the letter dated 8/1/2010 received from Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow for not to increase of seats in various Postgraduate Diploma courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 8/1/2010 received from Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow for not to increase of seats in various Postgraduate Diploma courses at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow and decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for increase of seats in (i) D.O., (ii) DMRD, (iii) D.Ortho., (iv) DGO, (v) DA, (vi) DTCD & (vii) DLO at Era's Lucknow Medical College, Lucknow u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as there is no provision u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

107. Further extension of time period required for submission of compliance report regarding deficiencies pointed out by Council during inspections of Government Medical Colelges at Akola, Dhule and Kolhapur.

Read: the letter dated 7/1/2010 received from the Secretary to the Government of Mahatrashtra with regard to starting of various PG courses at Government Medical Colleges, Akola, Dhule and Kolhapur.

The Postgraduate Committee noted that an inspection to assess the facilities of teaching faculty, residents, clinical material, hostels and other infrastructure facilities etc. vis-à-vis the minimum standard requirements for the number of students for which the college is recognized for the award of MBBS degree was carried out by the Council inspectors in August - September, 2009 and inspection reports were considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 25th September, 2009. In view of the deficiencies pointed out in the inspection reports, the committee decided that the institution be asked for the compliance within the period of one month.

The above decision of the Executive Committee was communicated to the college authorities with a copy to the State Govt. On 30.09.2009 and further reminder was sent on 01.01.2010 for expediting the report.

The Committee considered the letter dated 07.01.2010 received from the Secretary to the Govt. of Maharashtra, Medical Education & Drug Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai requesting for extension of time period by further 2 months for submission of compliance in respect of Govt. Medical Colleges at Akola, Kolhapur & Dhule.

In view of the Govt. of India letter dated 15.3.2005 issued after the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case of Mridul Dhar V/s UOI & Ors. requesting the Council to strictly adhere to the time schedule prescribed under the Regulations, and as per the Schedule prescribed in the opening of a New or Higher course of study or training (including postgraduate course of study or training and increase of admission capacity in any course of study or training (including a postgraduate course of study or training), Regulations, 2000, the last date for sending the recommendations of the MCI for grant of Letter of Permission to the Central Govt. being 28th February, the Members of the Postgraduate Committee decided to return the application to the Central Govt.

recommending disapproval of the Scheme for starting of various PG courses at Govt. Medical College, Akola, Sri Bhausaheb Hire Govt. Medical College, Dhule & Govt. Medical College, Kolhapur received u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 as the Govt. of Maharashtra has requested extension of time for submission of compliance by 2 months vide letter dated 07.01.2010 and it is not possible for the MCI to process the applications within the time Schedule prescribed in the Regulations.

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Subharti Medical College, Meerut under Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar University, Agra for starting of MD(Paediatrics) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance submitted by the Principal, Subharati Medical College, Meerut vide its letter dated 20.01.2010 together with the Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an inspection.

113. Starting of MS(ENT) & D.L.O. courses at Padit Deen Dayal Upadhyay Medical College, Rajkot under Saurashtra University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

Read: the letter dated 15/01/2010 received from the Central Govt. Ministry of Health & F.W. requesting to consider the proposal for starting of MS(ENT) & D.L.O. courses at P.D.U. Medical College, Rajkot under Saurashtra University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the letter dated 15/01/2010 received from the Central Govt. Ministry of Health & F.W. requesting to consider the proposal for starting of MS(ENT) & D.L.O. courses at P.D.U. Medical College, Rajkot under Saurashtra University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and noted that as per the Schedule prescribed in the Regulations for receipt of application for opening or to increase the admission capacity in respect of postgraduate medical courses and its processing by the Central Govt. and MCI - receipt of letter from the Central Govt. by the MCI for consideration for issue of letter of permission is 30th November of the calendar year.

The Postgraduate Committee further noted that the Central Govt. has forwarded the letter on 15.01.2010 after the last date and decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for starting of MS(ENT) & D.L.O. courses at P.D.U. Medical College, Rajkot under Saurashtra University for the academic year 2010-2011 u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as there is no provision u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

114. Starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Sardar Patel Medical College, Bikaner u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (November, 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Sardar Patel Medical College, Bikaner for starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (November, 2009) and decided to reiterate its earlier decision taken at its meeting held on 29.12.2009 recommending to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Forensic Medicine) course at Sardar Patel Medical College, Bikaner under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 as compliance is unsatisfactory, because the following deficiencies are still persisting:-

1. Promotion of Dr. P.N. Mathur, Professor & HOD, is not as per MCI norms as he has been promoted to the post of Professor after 3 years 10 months and 20 days service as Associate Professor.
2. Dr. Anis Ahmed, Assistant Professor, does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.
3. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is inadequate.
4. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

115. Deferment of compliance PG inspection at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur.

Read: the matter with regard to deferment of compliance PG inspection at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to deferment of compliance PG inspection viz. MS(ENT), MS(Ophthalmology), MD(Obst. & Gynae.), MS(Orthopaedics), MD(Psychiatry) at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur and decided to return the application to the Central Govt. recommending disapproval of the Scheme for increase of seats in (i) MS(ENT), (ii) MS(Ophthalmology), (iii) MD(Obst. & Gynae.), (iv) MS(Orthopaedics) & (v) MD(Psychiatry) at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956, as there is no

provision u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or the regulations framed therein to keep the application pending in the Council office.

116. Starting of MD(Community medicine) course at Maharaja's Instt. Of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram u/s of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (Jan.,10) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Maharaja's Instt. Of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram for starting of MD(Community medicine) course under NTR University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (Jan.,10) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Community medicine) course at Maharaja's Instt. Of Medical Sciences, Vizianagaram under NTR University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 because of the followings:-

1. There is deficiency of 2 Assoc. Professors.
2. Resultantly, the teaching faculty component is inadequate.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

117. Starting of MD(Geriatrics) course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi, Kerala under the Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance verification inspection report (Jan.10) alongwith the earlier inspection report (Sept.,2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Amrita Instt. Of Medicine, Kochi, Kerala for starting of MD(Geriatrics) course under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report (Jan.,10) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD (Geriatrics) course at Amrita Instt. Of Medicine, Kochi, Kerala under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam u/s 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 because of the followings:-

1. Dr.Bhaskaran Chalil, Prof. & Head and Dr.Priya Vijayakumar, Asstt. Prof. are not having recognized postgraduate qualification.
2. Resultantly, the teaching faculty component is inadequate.
3. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.
