The Chairman welcomed the members of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

The minutes of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 06/11/2015 were read out and confirmed in the meeting itself.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the previous meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the adjourned item nos. 36 – 66, 68, 77 – 81, 96 – 111, 114 – 118 & 120 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 06/11/2015.

36. Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow - Recognition of MS(ENT) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at Command Hospital, Lucknow.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (24/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014) and compliance dated 07/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(ENT) qualification for 01 seat at Command Hospital, Lucknow granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (24/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014) and compliance dated 07/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(ENT) qualification for 01 seat granted by Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj Medical University, Lucknow in respect of students being trained at Command Hospital, Lucknow because of the following facts:-

1. As per certificate issued by the Competent Authority of the office of Director General, Armed Forces Medical Services, Dr. A.V. Ramesh was graded specialist for 4 months and classified specialist for 2 years 7 months and advisor for 5 years and 9 months. Hence, his promotion from Assistant Professor to Associate Professor and from Assoc. Professor to Professor is not as per Regulations and he cannot be accepted as Professor & Head of department.
2. As per the old report, Dr. A.V. Ramesh was shown as Assistant Professor from July 2008 to June 2011 at Army Hospital, Delhi. In the compliance report, he has been shown as Assistant Professor from July 2008 to Sept. 2011. In the old report, he was shown Assoc. Professor from July, 2013 to April, 2014 at Command Hospital Central Command. In the compliance verification, he has been shown as Assoc. Professor from July, 2013 to August, 2014. Retrospective change of dates cannot be accepted.
3. Out of the four publications cited to his credit no full reference or reprint of any of them has been provided. There are no author names given. Out of the four, two are case reports (Sr. No. 1, 4) and one is in Brazilian Journal, which cannot be accepted. Resultantly, only 1 publication is left to his credit. He was promoted as Prof. in Sept. 2014 after the cut-off date without 4 publications, which is again not as per regulations.
4. Both, Senior Residents (Dr. Mahipal Singh and Dr. Archana) with DLO qualification are not eligible. They have no three years experience in ENT at the time of appointment as Senior Residents.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

37. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. - Renewal of recognition of DLO qualification for 02 seat in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (20/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014 & March, 2015) and compliance dated 20/06/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of DLO qualification for 02 seat at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P..

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (20/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014 & March, 2015) and compliance dated 20/06/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to renew the recognition of DLO qualification for 02 seats granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. Keerthi Kumar Patgaya, Prof. & HOD was never Assistant or Associate Professor. Resultantly, his promotion to the post of Professor is not as per the regulations. Hence he cannot be accepted as Professor & HOD.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 02 seats till renewal of their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of recognition granted u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"...the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

38. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MS(ENT) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College Aurangabad.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (20/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2013 & February, 2015) and compliance dated 05/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(ENT) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats at Govt. Medical College Aurangabad granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (20/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2013 & February, 2015) and compliance dated 05/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(ENT) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College Aurangabad because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. Sunil Deshmukh is working in Cancer Hospital and not in the Deptt. of ENT. Hence, he cannot be considered.
2. One Senior Resident has been demoted from Asstt. Prof but no orders of his demotion or joining report as Senior Resident is attached.
3. There were only 476 Major operations in 2014 implying daily average of 1.6 which is inadequate. It does not correlate with 4 Major operations being performed daily as claimed.
4. Professor & HOD was absent during assessment.
5. Faculty was totally unprepared for assessment. There was no help from clerical staff in preparation of SAF.
6. There is no Speech Therapist.
7. Hearing aid trials are not undertaken.
8. Neonatal screening programme is not provided.
9. Investigation facilities like Nerve Conduction are not available.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 1 to 2 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

39. Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur - Recognition of MD/MS(OBG) qualification for 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Pushpagiri Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Tiruvalla, Kerala..

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (20/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2014) and compliance dated 08/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD/MS(OBG) qualification for 2 seats at Pushpagiri Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Tiruvalla, Kerala granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (20/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2014) and compliance dated 08/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognise MD/MS(OBG) qualification for 02 seats granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur in respect of students being trained at Pushpagiri Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Tiruvalla, Kerala because of the following facts:-

1. With regard to payment of stipend, no pay slip issued to individual Resident was provided by the institute.
2. Dr. Anjana & Dr. Athira cannot be accepted as Senior Residents due to reasons mentioned in report.; Resultantly, there is shortage of Senior Resident: 1.
3. Normal abortions are only 59 & MTP workload is NIL. College claims to have a tie up with local private hospital which is not permissible.
4. Specialty clinic like Gynaec Endocrine clinic is not run. Neither the name of Endocrinologist nor any details regarding him were provided to assessor. Deficiency remains as it is.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 02 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

40. Tripura University - Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification for 1 seat in respect of students being trained at Agartala Govt. Medical College, Agartala, Tripura.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (16/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014) and compliance dated 13/04/2015 submitted

by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Psychiatry) qualification for 1 seat at Agartala Govt. Medical College, Agartala, Tripura granted by Tripura University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (16/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014) and compliance dated 13/04/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MD (Psychiatry) qualification for 01 seat granted by Tripura University in respect of students being trained at Agartala Govt. Medical College, Agartala, Tripura because of the following facts:-

1. Daily average OPD is only 40. OPD on day of assessment is 41.
2. There are only 2 publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years: of these, 1 is a case report & hence cannot be considered.
3. Promotion of Dr. J. Debbarma, Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 3 years 2 months as Asst. Prof. against requirement of 5 years as per Regulations; hence he cannot be considered.
4. Resultantly there is no Asso. Prof. in the Unit; hence faculty complement is incomplete in the only Unit.
5. If, Dr. Punjadha Dass was working for the last 10 years, why was he shown as Honorary in last report.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

41. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (10/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2013 & February, 2015) and compliance dated 29/04/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) ualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (10/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2013 & February, 2015) and compliance dated 29/04/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize M.Ch. (Plastic Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore because of the following facts:-

1. Promotion of Dr. K.T. Ramesh, Professor & HOD is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted as Professor with experience of only 3 years as Asso. Prof. against requirement of 4 years as per Regulations. Further, he has only 6 ½ years teaching experience from Asst. Prof. onwards; hence he cannot be considered PG teacher. He has no publications to his credit.
2. There are no Senior Residents.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 2 to 4 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

42. Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur - Recognition of DM(Nephrology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Kozhikode,Calicut,Kerala.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (22/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (October, 2013) and compliance dated 19/04/2014 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of DM(Nephrology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats at Govt. Medical College, Kozhikode,Calicut,Kerala granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (22/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (October, 2013) and compliance dated 19/04/2014 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize DM (Nephrology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Kozhikode,Calicut,Kerala because of the following facts:-

1. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years. Only articles have been submitted; no proof of acceptance is provided. Deficiency remains as it is.
2. Details of experience as Resident in Nephrology department in medical college have not been provided in respect of any Senior Resident.
3. Space for faculty is inadequate.
4. Professor & Associate Professor has been shown as Assistant Professor prior to passing DM, which is not permissible.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Seats were permitted in 2008, which have not been recognized, till date.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee is of the considered opinion that the failure on the part of your Institution to timely rectify the deficiencies show that the standard of Postgraduate medical education is not maintained in your Institute and therefore, you are called upon to submit the reply as to why directions for stoppage of admissions in Postgraduate Courses DM (Nephrology) be not issued from academic year 2015-2016.

The reply to this Show-Cause must reach to the office of the Council within a period of 15 days from the issue of the Notice failing which the Council may decide the matter on the basis of available material.

43. Tripura University - Recognition of MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Agartala Govt. Medical College, Agartala, Tripura.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014) and compliance dated 13/04/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification for 02 seats at Agartala Govt. Medical College, Agartala, Tripura granted by Tripura University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (11/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2014) and compliance dated 13/04/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Radio-Diagnosis) qualification for 02 seats granted by Tripura University in respect of students being trained at Agartala Govt. Medical College, Agartala, Tripura because of the following facts:-

1. Professor & HOD has already crossed 70 years and there is no other Professor in the Department.
2. One Associate Professor was not present on the day of assessment. Resultantly, there is deficiency of one Professor and one Associate Professor.
3. DSA is not available
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 02 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

44. Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur - Recognition of DM(Gastroenterology) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at Dr SN Medical College, Jodhpur.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (19/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (September, 2014) and compliance dated 16/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of DM(Gastroenterology) qualification for 01 seat at Dr SN Medical College, Jodhpur granted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (19/08/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (September, 2014) and compliance dated 16/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that DM(Gastroenterology) qualification for 01 seat granted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur in respect of students being trained at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

45. Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Thrissur.

Read: the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (30/07/2015) along with the Council Assessor's Report (June, 2014 & March, 2015) and compliance dated 26/05/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification for 02 seats at Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Thrissur granted by Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

This is not feasible as he could not be at both places during the same period. Further, the period of his training in Cardiac Anaesthesia (whether it was for 2 years or not) is not shown separately.
3. Deficiency with regard to training of Dr. Abhijit B. Shitole remains as such. Narayan Hrudayalaya is not a recognized teaching institute by MCI.
4. Period of training of Dr. N.S. Mahantshetty in Cardiac Anaesthesia is not shown in faculty table. Hence it cannot be verified whether he has received 2 years' training in Cardiac Anaesthesia.
5. It is not clearly shown whether any of 2 Senior Residents has worked for 3 years as Resident in this department (i.e. Cardiac Anaesthesia) or not.
6. With regard to Dr. S.S. Patil, his period of service at Sri Ramchandra Institute is 1 year 9 months only which being < 2 years cannot be considered.
7. Resultantly, faculty complement is incomplete.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

6. Dr. Sejal Mehta, Senior Resident, does not possess experience of 3 years in a medical college; hence not eligible to hold the post.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. MRD: It is still under process of computerization. Deficiency remains as it is.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

2. Dr. V.B. Reddy & Dr. M. Setty, shown as Medical Officers possess MBBS qualification only; hence not qualified to hold the post of lecturer cum M.O. at RHTC/UHC.
3. Statistician is B.Com which is not acceptable and there is no epidemiologist.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Rural Institute of

Medical Sciences & Research, Etawah, Uttar Pradesh under C.S.J.M. University, Kanpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17 as the compliance is not satisfactory because of the following facts:

1. Explanation of the institute that in this region of North India Ophthalmic cases decrease in summer cannot be accepted (Summer has not yet set in). No compliance is shown as to how bed occupancy has increased. Nothing is shown in compliance about the measures taken to increase operative workload of Major & Minor operations.
2. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

6. OPD attendance on day of assessment was 112; most of the patients are entered with diagnosis of Cough only.
7. PFT machine does not have DLCO.
8. There is no separate MDR ward facility for treatment of MDR Tuberculosis.
9. Bronchoscopy workload is 2-3/month which is too low.
10. Documents of stipend paid to PG students are not provided.
11. Except Asthma & Allergy clinic, no other specialty clinic is run.
12. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Stipend paid by Govt. of Andhra Pradesh to I/II/III year residents is Rs. 21,000; Rs. 23,000 & Rs. 25,000 p.m. respectively while that paid by the institute is Rs. 21,000; Rs. 22,000 & Rs. 23,000 p.m. respectively which is less for II/III year Residents and not in accordance with Regulations. Residents receive their stipend in cash which cannot be verified.
5. Though D.F. of faculty shows them as full timers with no private practice, salary paid to them is Rs. 60,000 for Professor, Rs. 50,000 p.m. for Asso. Prof. & Rs. 40,000 p.m. for Asst. Prof. which is too low. Form 16 was provided by institute & not downloaded from Income Tax website.
6. Though Senior Residents are with this institute since 2012-2013, their actual involvement in clinical work & teaching was not evidenced.
7. Equipment are inadequate as under:
 - (a) Only 2 Portable USG machines instead of 3;
 - (b) Shared Laparoscopy with General Surgery;
 - (c) NIL Hysteroscopy Unit;
 - (d) Only 1 Non-stress test machine.
8. Unnecessary hospitalization was noted for both Obstetrics & Gynaecology admissions.
9. Number of patients in OPD appeared to be much less as compared with OPD registration for day.
10. Monthly statistics of variety of clinical work are not available.
11. Data of clinical material are not completely provided.
12. Details of books purchased in last 3 years in Departmental Library are not provided.
13. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. There is only 1 publication from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
6. Shortage of Senior Residents: 2.
7. Specialty clinic like Cardiovascular Diseases clinic is not run.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 4 to 6 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 1. Prescribed SAF for 2016-17 has not been used.
2. The number of following investigations was NIL on day of assessment:
 - (a) Special investigations like Ba, IVP;
 - (b) Mammography;
 - (c) CT/USG guided procedure like FNAC;
 - (d) DSA.
3. On checking the records, the number of such cases as shown in data provided could not be corroborated. Further, not a single DSA investigation has been performed in last 3 months.
4. MRI workload of the entire hospital was 11 on day of assessment which is inadequate. It is only of 0.2 Tesla.

5. Number of annexures like PNDDT data, Ethics Committee minutes, CPC meetings have not been submitted.
6. Departmental archiving of teaching material like X-rays, MRI CT films is not satisfactory.
7. Details of books & journals in Departmental Library are not provided.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Seats were permitted in 2009, which have not been recognized.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee is of the considered opinion that the failure on the part of your Institution to timely rectify the deficiencies show that the standard of Postgraduate medical education is not maintained in your Institute and therefore, you are called upon to submit the reply as to why directions for stoppage of admissions in Postgraduate Courses MD (Radio-Diagnosis) and DMRD be not issued from academic year 2015-2016.

The reply to this Show-Cause must reach to the office of the Council within a period of 15 days from the issue of the Notice failing which the Council may decide the matter on the basis of available material.

3. There are some discrepancies about data of some investigations as provided on P.2 & P. 15 of SAF. Data of average daily investigative work are not available.
4. No registers are available for specialized services provided by department.
5. Equipment like Biofeedback, Lithium Analyzer, Alcohol Breath Analyzer are not available. EEG is available with Neurology department.
6. Department does not participate in National Mental Health Programme.
7. For year 2011 & 2012, Dr. Y. Sanjay is shown as PG teacher; but according to his D.F., he was working at ASRAMS, Elluru during the same period as Asso. Prof.

8. Non-teaching staff like Clinical Psychologist & Psychiatric Social Worker are not available.
9. Registers are not available for Academic parameters.
10. Average daily consumption of blood is shown as 1-2 in 2014 which appears to be not feasible.
11. Specialty clinic like Psychomotor clinic is not available.
12. Bio feedback is not available.
13. There are no publications.
14. There is no faculty table given in the SAF.
15. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 1. Out of 3 publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years, 1 relates to department of Community Medicine & not to ENT department.
2. Record of academic parameters for PG students was not provided; hence could not be verified.
3. OPD: Space is very less and practically there is no waiting area.
4. No Specialty clinic is run by the department.
5. Temporal Bone Dissection Laboratory is not available.
6. BERA is not available.
7. EMG, Microdebrider, Nerve Stimulator are not available.
8. Hearing aid trials, Neonatal Screening Programme are not conducted.

9. Details of individual surgeries for last 3 years were not provided.
10. Average stay of patients is 10-14 days which is too high for this department which is mainly a daycare department now. 3 patients were shown in ICU on day of assessment (i.e. 03/08/2015) who were operated on 01/08/2015 without any specific indication for being in ICU.
11. Departmental office, Seminar Room are non-functional.
12. Departmental Library is not separate.
13. Workload of Speech therapy is NIL on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days.
14. Workload of Impedance Audiometry was NIL during last 3 years.
15. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01st September 2015) and compliance dated 31/10/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, Maharashtra under Datta Meghe Instt. of Medical Sciences (Univ.), Nagpur for Increase of seats in MD(Pathology) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (01st September 2015) and compliance dated 31/10/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to verify the compliance by way of assessment.

118. Starting of MD(Emergency Medicine) course at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, Maharashtra under Datta Meghe Instt. of Medical Sciences (Univ.), Nagpur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17 – consideration of compliance.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (01st September 2015) and compliance dated 31/10/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Sawangi (Meghe), Wardha, Maharashtra under Datta Meghe Instt. of Medical Sciences (Univ.), Nagpur for Starting of MD(Emergency Medicine) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

3. Casualty beds are counted as Emergency Medicine beds which is not permissible. Explanation of institute that there are no guidelines is not acceptable as the guidelines for a PG Unit have been well defined in PG Medical Education Regulations.
4. Deficiency of no training in Emergency Medicine by any faculty remains as such. Experience in Casualty department in the same institute where department of Emergency medicine did not exist cannot qualify as training in Emergency Medicine.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (25/08/2015) and compliance dated 04/11/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the physical and other teaching facilities available at S.D.M. College of Medical Sciences & Hospital, Dharwad, Karnataka under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka for Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (25/08/2015) and compliance dated 04/11/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at S.D.M. College of Medical Sciences & Hospital, Dharwad, Karnataka u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2016-2017 from 02 (two) to 04(four) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

2. Obstetric Major operations are NIL on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days.
3. Number of Caesarean Sections is only 169 in 2014 indicating daily average of < 0.5 which is inadequate.
4. Average bed occupancy in HDU is 3-4/week implying poor quality of teaching material.
5. Total deaths last year (entire hospital – 6 out of 16037 admissions and in OBGY- Nil out of 2291 admissions). This simply indicates that no serious patients were admitted or the data provided is non-genuine.
6. Total blood units used on inspection day in the entire hospital – 4 units, average daily 6 to 8 units. This is sufficient indication that no serious emergencies are admitted in the hospital and without this the training of postgraduate students is inadequate.
7. Radiological workload on inspection day is grossly inadequate (MRI-7, Barium/IVP-6, Ultrasound-56)
8. Total IPD of 2014 was 2291. However, total Major Operations+Minor Operations+Deliveries and Caesarian sections (excluding day care surgeries) were 2976 which is more than total IPD and it is not feasible. Obviously the data is non-genuine.
9. Senior Resident Dr. Parvatha Verthini with DNB qualification is not eligible. She has no 03 years experience at the time of appointment.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (04th November 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MD (General Medicine) course at Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences, Maduranthagam, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. OPD attendance on day of assessment is 93 which is inadequate. Daily average is 80-90.
2. On inspection day, bed occupancy in ICU was 60% and ICCU 60%. There were only 03 patients in Casualty till 2 pm.
3. Blood Units consumed 1 to 2 units per day.
4. Total deaths in 2014 – 2 out 3550 admissions in Medicine department and 06 out of 16037 admissions in entire hospital. This obviously indicates that

there were no serious patients admitted or the data provided is non-genuine.

5. Radiological workload was grossly insufficient for the entire hospital which was as follows:

7. Promotion of Dr. V. Sakthivadivel, Associate Prof., Unit IV is not as per Regulations. He was promoted on 23.09.2014 after the cut off date of the transitory period without any publications which is not as per Regulations. No reference of his two publications cited has been given.
8. Resultantly, Unit II and Unit IV are left with 02 faculty each and hence, they cannot be considered as PG Units.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

In case, the college authorities wish to submit any compliance, the same should reach this Office, directly within one month along with supporting documentary evidence. Incomplete/ without proper documents, the compliance would not be entertained/ considered.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (04th November 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to disapprove the scheme for Starting of MS (Orthopaedics) course at Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences, Maduranthagam, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, because of the following facts:-

1. OPD attendance is 95 on day of assessment which is inadequate. Average is only 84/day.
2. There was only 1 Major & 2 Minor operations on day of assessment which is inadequate.
3. Total number of patients admitted in 2014 are 1,330; however number of Major operations in 2014 are 1597 which is not feasible. There is data mismatch.

4. HOD's office seemed to be non-functional on day of assessment. There are no proper cubicles for other staff. There is no adequate area for staff offices.
5. There is no dedicated trauma center. No trauma patient was seen on day of assessment.
6. Many patients admitted were not worthy of admission; e.g. one month old operated clavicle with full range of movements admitted for Physiotherapy.
7. Previous week's record showed daily one elbow dislocation & 1 shoulder dislocation which does not appear to be convincing.
8. Promotion of Dr. Sankarlal, Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as he has been promoted with experience of only 2 years as Asst. Prof. against requirement of 5 y; hence he cannot be considered as faculty; resultantly there is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I & faculty complement is incomplete.
9. Total deaths in the department last year – 02 out of 1330 admissions and total deaths in the hospital – 06 out of 16037 admissions. This obviously indicates that there were no serious patients admitted or the data provided is non-genuine.
10. Radiological workload on inspection day in the entire hospital was grossly inadequate, which was as follows:

She was promoted Professor on 07.10.2014 after the cut off date of the transitory period without 04 publications which is not as per Regulations.
