The Chairman welcomed the members of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

Leave of absence was received from Prof. (Dr.) Dhruba Jyoti Borah, Member, Dr. Kailash Sharma, Member and Dr. Rani Bhaskaran, Member.

**1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.**

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee confirmed the minutes of Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2016 with the following modification in resolution I, line -3 i.e. "...11(2) inspection for recognition of increased seats need not be held on the day of examination." be read corrected as "...11(2) inspection for recognition of increased seats or new course (same subject) of any other college affiliated to the same university need not be held on the day of examination.

**2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.**

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee noted & approved the action taken on the minutes of the previous meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the E-mail dated 24/02/2016 from Prof. Raj Bahadur, Vice Chancellor, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot and Member, MCI regarding dismal state of postgraduate students in the department of Surgery and Anaesthesia in Gian Sagar Medical College & Hospital, Ramnagar, Distt. Patiala.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee deliberated on the matter and decided that Prof. Raj Bahadur being Vice Chancellor of affiliating university of the college may get the college inspected and consider withdrawal of affiliation if there are deficiencies in infrastructure, faculty and clinical material. At the same time, he may submit factual ground reality report to MCI for further appropriate action by the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee in the matter.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee resolved that all compliances be placed before Scrutiny Sub-Committee (which should meet as per need) and the Sub-Committee should refer those which need verification by assessment to Assessment Cell without delay. This is to cut delay in adjudicating the reports.

3. **Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at A. J. Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification for 01 seat at A. J. Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification for 01 seat granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at A. J. Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

4. **Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh - Recognition of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification for 02 seats at Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that M.Ch.(Plastic Surgery) qualification for 02 seats granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh in respect of students being trained at

Andhra Medical College, Visakhapatnam be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**5. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore - Recognition of MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (October, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification for 02 seats at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (October, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Forensic Medicine) qualification for 02 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum because of the following facts:-

1. Dr. Ashok K. Shetty, Professor & HOD is promoted after cut-off date without any publications, which is not as per Regulations.
2. Workload of medico-legal work other than post-mortems is very low as under:
  - (a) Examination of Victims & Accused of Sexual Assault: 02/month;
  - (b) Age estimation of victims & accused of Sexual Assault: 02/month;
  - (c) Pregnancy certification: 01-02/year.
3. Academic parameter like Journal Club (17/year) is inadequate.
4. There is only 1 Foreign Journal of Forensic Medicine in Central Library, which is inadequate.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 02 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

*"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."*

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.



**6. Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot - Recognition of DM(Neurology) qualification for 01 seat in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Ludhiana.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of DM(Neurology) qualification for 01 seat at Christian Medical College, Ludhiana granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize DM(Neurology) qualification for 01 seat granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Ludhiana because of the following facts:-

1. Number of New OPD cases has decreased from 2,014 in 2012-2013 to 1,937 in 2014-2015. On the day of assessment, there were only 12 new cases in the OPD
2. Number of VEEG procedure has decreased from 33 to 25 during the same period.
3. Departmental Library has only 67 books.
4. The Institution is not paying stipend at Govt. rates. The information provided by the Institution that stipend paid in Government Colleges by the Government is Rs. 40,000 per month is factually incorrect. It is more than Rs. 40,000 at present.
5. There is no Senior Resident in the department.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

*"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."*

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. If no compliance is received within this period or compliance/ compliance verification is found unsatisfactory, it will result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course against the above mentioned seats.

**7. Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot - Recognition of MD(Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) qualification for 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) qualification for 03 seats at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Immuno Haematology & Blood Transfusion) qualification for 03 seats granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana because of the following facts:-

1. There is no Senior Resident.
2. All the faculty are M.D. (Pathology) & have no special training of two years in IHBT. All of them have been transferred to IHBT department from Pathology department in the same designation as in Pathology department, which is not permissible.
3. Only 5 books have been purchased in Departmental Library in last 3 years.
4. Total number of Blood units supplied has decreased from 13,766 in 2012 to 3,985 in 2014.
5. The Institution is not paying stipend at Govt. rates.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 03 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

*"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."*

In case, the college authorities desire to submit compliance, same should be received in this office preferably within four weeks of issue of this letter but definitely, prior to next admission so that the matter of recognition can be finally decided. Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of DM(Gastroenterology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that DM(Gastroenterology) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of

Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**9. Himachal Pradesh University - Recognition of MS(Orthopedics) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(Orthopedics) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 03 seats at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MS(Orthopedics) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 03 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**10. Himachal Pradesh University - Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**11. Himachal Pradesh University - Recognition of MD(Microbiology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Microbiology) qualification against



increased intake from 02 to 03 seats at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Microbiology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**12. Himachal Pradesh University - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**13. Himachal Pradesh University - Recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P granted by Himachal Pradesh University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University in respect of students being trained at Dr. Rajendar Prasad Government Medical College, Tanda, H.P because of the following facts:-

1. Total number of OPD patients has decreased from 32,347 to 29,109 during 3 year period.

2. Central O<sub>2</sub> and Central Suction are not available.
3. Casualty services are inadequate. ATCS Protocol is not observed.
4. Emergency OT is far away from Casualty.
5. 2 Medical Officers from State Health Services, Dr. Rajesh Ahluwalia and Dr. Nikhil Ahluwalia have been designated as Asst. Professors, which is not permissible.
6. Dr. Atul Mahajan promoted Professor on 21/02/2015 after the cut-off date without any publications, which is not as per Regulations. Resultantly, Unit-III is left with only 2 Faculty and it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
7. Dr. Raj Kumar Sharma promoted Professor on 05/12/2014 after the cut-off date without any publications, which is not as per Regulations.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 02 to 05 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. This is also clarified in the letter of permission granted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 issued for these seats, which reads as under:

*"This permission for starting/ increase of seats in the above course and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course appears for the first final examination in the subject."*

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (October, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Radiotherapy) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 03 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Father Muller Medical College, Mangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.



**15. Jiwaji University - Renewal of recognition of DMRD qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (December, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of DMRD qualification for 02 seats at Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior granted by Jiwaji University.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (December, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that recognition of DMRD qualification for 02 seats granted by Jiwaji University in respect of students being trained at Gajra Raja Medical College, Gwalior be renewed.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.

**16. Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot - Recognition of MD(Community Medicine) qualification for 02 seats in respect of students being trained at Gian Sagar Medical College & Hospital, Patiala.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2015) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Community Medicine) qualification for 02 seats at Gian Sagar Medical College & Hospital, Patiala granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (August, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize MD(Community Medicine) qualification for 02 seats granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Gian Sagar Medical College & Hospital, Patiala because of the following facts:-

1. No deliveries are conducted in RHTC.
2. In respect of 2 faculty, residential proof submitted is one which is not in the list of acceptable proofs.
3. Stipend paid by State Govt. to Residents is Rs. 40,000 p.m. while that paid by the institute to I/II/III year Residents is Rs. 18,000; Rs. 19,000 & Rs. 20,000 p.m. respectively which is less and contrary to Regulations. The information provided by the Institution that stipend paid in Government Colleges by the Government is Rs. 40,000 per month is factually incorrect. It is more than Rs. 40,000 at present.
4. Non-teaching staff like Peon is not available at RHTC & van driver is not available at PHC.
5. Academic parameters like Journal Club (18/year), Group Discussions (05 in no.) are inadequate.
6. There is no Epidemiologist.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 02 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the

2. Promotion of Dr. Ravi N., Assoc. Professor is not as per Regulations. He was Asst. Professor for 4 years 11 months against the requirement of 5 years.
3. Mortuary facilities are inadequate. Fly catcher, Mourners' room & Doctors' room are not available.
4. Open Mortuary with fly proofing arrangement is not available.
5. In Museum, models are not available.
6. Academic parameters like Journal Clubs (20/year), Group Discussions (12/year) are inadequate.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat till renewal of their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 3. PG students' exposure to new technologies like Antibody Screening, Antibody identification, Use of Column Agglutination, Use of Leukocyte Filter, HLA technology, Stem Cell Preparation is inadequate.
4. Paramedical Staff like Laboratory Technicians is inadequate.
5. Departmental Library has 55 books.
6. Workload of investigations like PT, APTT, TT, Coagulation disorders is NIL.
7. Academic parameters like Theory Classes (19/year), Journal Clubs (08 in no.), Group Discussions (09 in no.) are inadequate.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. The department does not participate in National programme for Prevention & Control of Deafness.
6. Dr. Rajesh Kupadhy was promoted Professor on 22/04/2015 after the cut-off date without any publications, which is not as per Regulations. All publications cited are Case Report hence, cannot be considered.
7. Dr. Rajlaxmi, Professor promoted on 24/04/2015 after the cut-off date without any publications, which is not as per Regulations. All publications cited are Case Report hence, cannot be considered.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

5. Dr. Zahiruddin Khan was Asst. Professor for 2 years 9 months against the requirement of 5 years. His experience at Military Hospital 164 cannot be counted because that is not in the list of approved Military Hospitals.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

4. HIV related services are not provided.
5. MRI workload for the whole hospital is only 05 & CT Scan workload is only 08 on day of assessment.
6. Most of 13 publications are in non-indexed journals and not related with the subject.
7. Academic parameter like Journal Club (18/year) is inadequate.
8. Promotion of Dr. Samarindra Mahapatra, Professor, Unit-II is not as per Regulations. He was Assoc. Professor for 3 years against the requirement of 4 years without any publications during the period of Assoc. Professorship.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 06 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 4. Date expired drugs were found on Emergency tray.
5. Space for department is inadequate. Waiting space for patients is < 300 sq.ft.
6. Space for Non Invasive Cardiology Laboratory is inadequate. TMT room is < 120 sq.ft.
7. There is no Ambulatory BP monitoring, OCT and FFR equipment available.
8. Dr. Sanjay Porwal, Assoc. Professor is DNB from non-teaching hospital. His appointment is not as per Regulations. He had no 3 years teaching experience at the time of appointment.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat till renewal of their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. Andhra Medical College and Siddhartha Medical College, Vijayawada do not have DM (Cardiology). Hence, experience of those colleges cannot be considered. Resultantly, his promotion is not as per Regulations.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. 01 seat after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. 1. There are NIL publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
2. Permission for conducting medico-legal post-mortems is not available.
3. Although institute is not permitted for conducting medico-legal post-mortems, it has provided of medico-legal work on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days of Government General Hospital, which cannot be accepted.
4. Workload of medico-legal examination of victims of sexual assault and of Pregnancy Certification is NIL on day of assessment as well as on randomly selected days.
5. Workload of medico-legal work is NIL during last 3 years.
6. Academic parameters like Theory Classes (10 in no.), Journal Clubs (07 in no.), Group Discussions (NIL) are inadequate.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (July, 2015) and decided to recommend not to recognize M.Ch.(Cardio Thoracic Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 03 to 06 seats granted by Nizams Institute of Medical Sciences, (Deemed University), Hyderabad in respect of students being trained at Nizams Institute of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad because of the following facts:-

1. No details of Senior/Junior Residents are provided.
2. Dr. Muppiri Vijaya Kumar, Asso. Prof. was sent on fellowship to Australia from 27/08/2012 to 23/01/2015 as per the certificate issued; however he has also purportedly resumed at the institute on 23/08/2014 which is not feasible. He could not be doing fellowship and also serve at institute during the period from 23/08/2014 to 23/01/2015. Also, period spent on fellowship in Australia cannot be considered as teaching experience.
3. Resultantly, there is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I.
4. Both the Units have 32 & 31 beds respectively which is not as per Regulations.
5. Seminar room is not available. Enquiries revealed that classes are held in office without any infrastructure like writing board / slide screen / seating facility.
6. Research publications could not be assessed as the list was not in order and printouts were not available.
7. Operative statistics were also not in order.
8. Departmental Library has only 27 books.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the Assessment Report.

Admissions done (if any) against these seats i.e. increased intake from 03 to 06 seats after the first batch appeared in Examination till their recognition will be irregular/ illegal and not in accordance with MCI regulations (notified with prior permission of Central Government vide notification dated 21/07/2009) and will not be recognized. As per provisions of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000, failure to seek timely recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the concerned Post Graduate Course. 1. Total number of Major operations has decreased from 2,627 in 2012 to 2,398 in 2014.

2. Dr. Garima Tilwankar, Senior Resident possesses experience of only 1 year 6 months as Resident in medical college against 3 years required; hence not eligible to hold the post.
3. Dr. Javed Naghmi, Senior Resident possesses experience of only 2 years 10 months as Resident in medical college against 3 years required; hence not eligible to hold the post.
4. Deficiency of Senior Residents: 1.
5. The following investigations have decreased from 2012 to 2014 as shown in table:
