1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee noted that the minutes of Postgraduate Medical Education Committee meeting held on 24/05/2016, 03/06/2016, 12/07/2016, 26/07/2016, 09/08/2016, 30/08/2016 and 07/09/2016 are with Oversight Committee/ Central Government, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.

Action is being taken on the minutes of the meetings dated 17/06/2016 and 01/07/2016 upon receipt of the minutes from the Oversight Committee. Action on rest of the minutes will be taken on receipt of the minutes from the Oversight Committee.

The Committee also noted the 1st para of the decision of item No. 34 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee taken at its meeting held on 17/06/2016 and the corrected decision is as under:-

Decision

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (23/04/2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. that DCH qualification for 03 seats granted by JSS University, Mysore in respect of students being trained at JSS Medical College, Mysore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the IMC Act, 1956.

Corrected decision

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (23/04/2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. that the recognition of DCH qualification for 03 seats granted by JSS University, Mysore in respect of students being trained at JSS Medical College, Mysore be renewed.

3. Starting of MD (Family Medicine) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (29th August 2016) for Starting of MD (Family Medicine) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (29/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. There are 2 Units but only 1 Senior Resident; resultantly there is shortage of 1 Senior Resident.
2. Dr. Asha E. Mathew, Senior Resident in Unit I does not have 3 years experience as Resident in medical college affiliated hospital as required; hence not qualified to hold the post. There is no other Senior Resident in Unit I.
3. Dr. Venkatesan S, Assoc. Prof. Unit II has been shown Assoc. Prof. from 28.8.2013 till date and from 16.11.2010 to 15.11.2014. This is not feasible.
4. Faculty table is not signed by any faculty member.
5. The subject in which the faculty members have been working in different ranks has not been mentioned in the faculty table whether they were working in Family Medicine or the parent department in lower ranks need to be clarified.
6. Details of Special clinics run by the department are not provided.
7. Only 7 new books have been purchased in last 3 years for the Departmental Library.
8. Details of CPC are not provided.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD (Family Medicine) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

4. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (31st August 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under

Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (31/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Shortage of Senior Residents: 2.
2. Dr. D.S. Chouhan, Professor & HOD and Dr. M.L. Tak; Dr. R.K. Solanki; Dr. Geeta Singariya, all Professors have been promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however, in the column of "Benefit of publications", it is stated "No" implying there are NIL research publications against requirement of 4; hence their promotions are not as per Regulations & they cannot be considered.
3. Dr. Vikas Rajpurohit & Dr. Neelam Meena, both Asso. Prof. have been promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however, in the column of "Benefit of publications", it is stated "No" implying there are NIL research publications against requirement of 2; hence their promotions are not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
4. Dr. Rakhi Bansal, Senior Resident does not have 3 years experience as Resident in medical college affiliated hospital before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not qualified to hold the post.
5. Academic parameter like Journal Clubs (07 in no.) is inadequate.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

5. Starting of MD (Paediatrics) course at Government Medical College, Akola, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (19th August 2016) for Starting of MD (Paediatrics) course at Government Medical College, Akola, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (19/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Nilesh Dayama, Professor is employed on contractual basis; however it was observed that he only comes to department when he is free as he has his own private hospital. Hence he cannot be considered as full time. Further though he has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank against requirement of 4 research publications; hence also his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered. There is no other Professor.
2. Dr. Vinit Warthe, Asso. Prof. in Unit II has been promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank against requirement of 2 research publications; hence also his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered. He has shown to have worked as Assoc. Prof. from 20.11.2015 to 1.4.2016 and also as Professor from 2.4.2015 which is not feasible.
3. Dr. Abhay Bagal, Assoc. Prof. Unit-I is DNB from non-teaching hospital. He has no three years experience in a medical college at the time of

appointment as Asst. Professor. Hence, his appointment *ab-initio* is not as per regulations.

4. Dr.Rashmi, Sr.Resident Unit-II is not eligible, she has no three years experience as Jr. Resident in a medical college. Resultantly, Unit-II has no Sr.Resident.
5. There is no demonstration room in the department.
6. Departmental library does not have any journals and books are very outdated.
7. There are no rooms for faculty except one room for HOD and one room for one Associate Professor.
8. MRI is not available.
9. Although PICU beds are 5, occupancy is shown as 9 implying 180 % occupancy. NICU beds are 12 but occupancy is shown as 31 implying 258 % occupancy. Both these are not as per norms as there is very heavy chance of cross infection & transmission of morbidities in such cases.
10. There is no Demonstration room in the department; one room is designated as Demonstration room cum Library cum Museum but it does not have facility for teaching.
11. No National programme is conducted by the department.
12. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD (Paediatrics) course at Government Medical College, Akola, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

6. **Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun, Uttarakhand under Swami Rama Himalayan University, Dehradun U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (22th August 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun, Uttarakhand under Swami Rama Himalayan University, Dehradun U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (22/08/2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for Increase of seats in M.D.(Anaesthesia) course at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun, Uttarakhand under Swami Rama Himalayan University, Dehradun U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic year 2017-18 from 4(four) to 8(eight) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

7. **Starting of MD (Physiology) course at Integral Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Integral University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.**

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (30/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Seema Singh, Professor & HOD has been promoted as Professor with experience of only 2 years 11 months as Asso. Prof. against requirement of 3 years; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
2. Dr. Rubeena Bano has been shown as "Assoc. Prof." in the column of "Designation" in the faculty table; however, in the column of "Experience" he is shown as "Professor" w.e.f. 01/07/2016 till date, which is not feasible.
3. There is one demonstrator against the requirement of two.
4. In the column of "Stipend paid by the institute to Residents" it is stated "Not applicable" both with regard to that paid by State Govt. as well as that proposed to be paid by the institute.
5. Equipment like Digital Physiograph, Longen Dorth for Mammalian experiments are not available.
6. No details are given whether CPSEA guidelines are followed by Animal House or not.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of seats in MD (Physiology) course at Integral Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Integral University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

8. Starting of MD (Pharmacology) course at Integral Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Integral University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (30th August 2016) for Starting of MD (Pharmacology) course at Integral Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Integral University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (30/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Shortage of faculty: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1.
2. Clinical Pharmacology Laboratory is non-functional.
3. Equipment like Assembly Perfusion Operator for Mammalian Heart, Flame Photometer are not available.
4. Experiential laboratory is shared with Physiology Department.
5. Animal House is not available in this institute. There is one Animal House of Pharmacy College of the same University which is not acceptable.
6. In Departmental Library, total books are shown as 95; however number of books purchased in last 3 years is shown as 336 which is not feasible. This discrepancy needs to be clarified.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of seats in MD (Pharmacology) course at Integral Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under Integral University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

9. Increase of seats in MD (Pharmacology) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (19th August 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (Pharmacology) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

10. Starting of MD (Anatomy) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (19th August 2016) for Starting of MD (Anatomy) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (19th August 2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of M.D. (Anatomy) course at Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2017-2018 restricting the number of admissions to 3(Three) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The Teaching Institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

11. Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Kerala under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (30th August 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Kerala under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (30th August 2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Sam Philip has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date i.e. 1.2.2014. He has only two publication against the requirement of four, hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & cannot be considered. The college got first LOP to start MBBS course on 28.10.2002. He has

been given teaching experience from 28.2.2002 when the college was not in existence, which is not permissible.

2. Prof. Sara Carula has been promoted Professor on 1.6.2015 after the cut-off date. She has two publications against the requirement of 4. Hence, her promotion is not as per regulations.
3. Dr. Sunitha Zacharia has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date on 01/02/2014; however, in the list of publications cited in the faculty table, only 2 publications are shown against requirement of 4; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
4. Dr. Shalini Miriam Ipe, Senior Resident, does not have any experience as Resident before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not eligible to hold the post.
5. Resultantly there is shortage of Senior Resident: 1.
6. MRI workload for the whole hospital was only 06 on day of assessment. Major operation-15, Minor operation-5. Day care operation-3 which are grossly inadequate.
7. Faculty deficiency: (a) Assoc. Professor: 1 and (b) Asst. Professor: 1.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Government not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (Anaesthesia) course at Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Kerala under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

12. Starting of MS (ENT) course at Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Kerala under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (29th August 2016) for Starting of MS (ENT) course at Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Kerala under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (29/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Jacob C.E. has been shown as "Asso. Prof." in the column of "Designation" in the faculty table; however, in the column of "Experience" it is shown as "Professor" w.e.f. 01/06/2014 till date. Further, although his promotion is after cut-off date, in the column of "Benefit of publications", it is stated "No" implying there are NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered. He was Asstt. Prof. for four years six months against the required 5 years.
2. Dr. Asha A. Abraham has been shown as "Asso. Prof." in the column of "Designation" in the faculty table; however, in the column of "Experience" it is shown as "Professor" w.e.f. 01/01/2015 till date. This discrepancy needs to be clarified. Further, although his promotion is after cut-off date, in the column of "Benefit of publications", it is stated "No" implying there are NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
3. With regard to Dr. K.M. Thomas Rony, Asso. Prof., date upto which he worked as Asst. Prof. & from which he was promoted as Asso. Prof. is not shown in the faculty table. Hence it cannot be verified whether his promotion is as per Regulations or not.
4. Workload of operations like Laryngectomy, Laryngo/Tracheoplasty, Rhinoplasty, Maxillectomy, Angiofibroma is NIL.

5. MRI workload for the whole hospital is only 06 on day of assessment which is very inadequate.
6. On the day of inspection, total BERA-1, speech therapy – 2, which is inadequate.
7. From three years data, average daily major operation 1.2 in 2015, Minor operation 0.6 and speech therapy one per day.
8. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for MS (ENT) course at Malankara Orthodox Syrian Church Medical College, Kolenchery, Kerala under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

13. Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (29th August 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (29/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Bed Occupancy is 11.3 % on day of assessment, average of 3 days 16%.
2. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asso. Prof.: 2; (b) Asst. Prof.: 6.
3. Shortage of Senior Residents: 4.
4. Units I has no Assoc. Prof.; hence faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
5. Units II, III have only 2 faculty each; hence they cannot be considered as PG Units.
6. Units IV have only 1 faculty each; hence they cannot be considered as teaching Units.
7. Unit-V has only one faculty. Dr.P. Mohanraj, Assoc. Professor is not eligible because he was promoted Assoc. Prof. on 18.3.2016 after the cut-off date without any publications, which is not as per regulations.
8. CT Scan is 6 slice against requirement of 16 slice as per Regulations.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

14. Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (29th August 2016) for Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (29/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Shortage of Senior Residents: 4.
2. Dr. A. Ravinthar has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date on 17/06/2016; however the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying there are NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
3. Total deaths during last year 17 out of 5724 admissions which gives a death rate of .29% in a department like Surgery which deals with poly-trauma. It only indicates that no seriously ill patients are admitted.
4. Prof. P.S.Sara Vanan was promoted Professor on 11.9.2013 after the cut-off date without any publications which is not as per regulations. The college got first LOP to start MBBS course on 27.6.2003. However, he has been given teaching experience from 6.2.2003 when the college was not in existence which is not permissible. Resultantly, Unit-V is left with only one faculty.
5. CT Scan is 6 slice against requirement of 16 slice as per Regulations.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

15. Increase of seats in MS (Orthopaedics) course at Meenakshi Medical College and Research Institute, Enathur, Tamilnadu under Meenakshi University (Deemed), Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the matter along with Assessment Report dated 29.08.2016 and previous assessment reports (Feb., 2016), (Feb., 2015) & (April, 2014) and Court order dated 25.07.2016 Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and letter dated 03.06.2016 received from Registrar, Sikkim Manipal University alongwith Court order dated 25.05.2016 of Hon'ble High Court of Sikkim, Gangtok.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Assessment Report (29.08.2016) and previous assessment reports (Feb., 2016), (Feb., 2015) & (April, 2014) and Court order dated 25.07.2016 Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and letter dated 03.06.2016 received from Registrar, Sikkim Manipal University alongwith Court order dated 25.05.2016 of Hon'ble High Court of Sikkim, Gangtok and decided to recommend not to recognize MS(ENT) qualification granted by Sikkim Manipal Univ. of Health, Medical & Tech. Scs in respect of students being trained at Sikkim Manipal Institute of Medical Sciences, Gangtok because of the following facts:-

(A) Central Referral Hospital: (Own Hospital)

1. At item § 28 of Summary on P. 10, 2 Associate Professors are shown. However in the faculty table in Part II Departmental Information, on P. 16-17, no Associate Professor is shown in the only Unit. This discrepancy needs to be clarified. Resultantly faculty complement in the only Unit is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
2. Average Bed occupancy of randomly selected days is 70 %.
3. There was only 1 Major Operation on day of assessment against requirement of minimum 3. Average of randomly selected days is only 2 which also is inadequate.
4. Total workload of Major Operations in 2015 was only 160 implying daily average of 0.53 which is grossly inadequate.
5. Workload of BERA investigation was only 61 in 2015 implying daily average of 0.2.
6. Workload of Speech Therapy was only 154 in 2015 implying daily average of 0.51.
7. Workload of Direct Laryngoscopy, Foreign Body Removal, Myringotomy is NIL during preceding last 3 years.
8. Investigative facilities like Nerve Conduction, EMG are not available.
9. MRI workload on day of assessment is only 06.
10. The college got first LOP to start MBBS course on 31.8.2001. Prof. & HOD, Dr. Suvamoy Chakraborty has been given teaching experience from November, 2000 when the college was not in existence. Resultantly, he was Asstt. Prof. for 4 years 2 months and his promotion is not as per regulations.
11. As per faculty table, there is no Assoc. Professor.
12. Faculty table is not signed by any faculty member.
13. Three years clinical material given in table-8, summary and table 10 SAF part II do not tally with each other. All parameters are different. This indicates that data is non-genuine.
14. Academic para-meters last year Journal Club only-8, which is inadequate.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee resolved that opinion of Additional Solicitor General/ Solicitor General be obtained on the Order of the Hon'ble High Court of Sikkim dated 25/05/2016 in W.P. (C) No. 24 of 2015.
