1. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – confirmation of.

No objection/observation made by any member of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee. Minutes of the last meeting confirmed.

2. Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee – action taken thereon.

Action has been taken on the minutes of the meeting dated 17/06/2016, 01/07/2016, 12/07/2016 & 26/07/2016. Minutes of remaining meetings dated 24/05/2016, 03/06/2016, 09/08/2016, 30/08/2016, 07/09/2016 and 16/09/2016 still not received from the Oversight Committee.

3. Starting of MD (Pathology) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (07th September 2016) for Starting of MD (Pathology) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Karishma Gupta and Dr. Amar Bahadur Singh, has not signed the faculty table, which means both of them were absent.
2. Resultantly, deficiency of Associate Professor-1 & Assistant Professor-1.
3. Number of Biopsies on Day of assessment was only 04. Total workload of Biopsies is only 531 in 2015 implying daily average of 1.77.
4. Total workload of the following procedures / investigations is grossly inadequate in 2015:
 - (a) Exfoliative Cytology: 26;
 - (b) CT guided FNAC: 09;
 - (c) USG guided FNAC: 32.
 - (d) PT, APTT, TT investigations: NIL.
5. Equipment like HPLC, Blood Gas Analyzer are not available.
6. Facilities for Frozen Section, Coagulation Disorders investigations are not available.
7. Pathological post-mortems are not carried out.
8. Departmental library has no journals.
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD(Pathology) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

4. Starting of MD (Physiology) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (07th September 2016) for Starting of MD (Physiology) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. A.M.R. Deshkar, Professor & HOD has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however in the column of "Benefit of publications" in faculty table, it is stated "No" implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
2. Dr. Karishma Singh has been promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however in the column of "Benefit of publications" in faculty table, it is stated "No" implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
3. Dr. Pramod P. Kadu has been promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however in the column of "Benefit of publications" in faculty table, it is

stated "No" implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.

4. Equipment like EEG, Autonomic Function tests, Nerve Conduction studies, Evoke Potential studies, Digital Physiograph, Stethograph, Treadmill are not available.
5. Facilities for PG studies are not adequate and are insufficient.
6. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD(Physiology) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

5. **Starting of MD (Anatomy) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (07th September 2016) for Starting of MD (Anatomy) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD (Anatomy) u/s 10A of the I.M.C. The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 2 and Lady Medical Officer -1.
2. Paramedical staff like Health Educator is not available. MSW is not available at RHTC.
3. RHTC: It is not under full control of Dean.
4. Equipment like Spirometry is not available.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Chhattisgarh Institute of Medical Sciences, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh under Guru Ghasidas University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

7. Increase of seats in MD (Geriatric Medicine) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (2nd September 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (Geriatric Medicine) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (02/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. There are total 16 beds in the unit, which is not as per Regulations.
2. 6 ICU beds and 8 private ward beds cannot be counted towards unit beds.
3. Faculty table does not specify when faculty was shifted to Geriatric Medicine and their experience in earlier ranks in their parent department or Geriatric Medicine.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD(Geriatric Medicine) course at Christian Medical College, Vellore, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

8. Starting of MS (ENT) course at Government Medical College, Miraj, Sangli, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (02nd September 2016) for Starting of MS (ENT) course at Government Medical College, Miraj, Sangli, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (02/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. There is NIL Professor.
2. Bed Occupancy is 30 % on day of assessment.
3. On the day of assessment, nil major operation and nil minor operation.
4. There is no blood component separation facility. Resultantly qualifying criteria 8(6) of Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations is not fulfilled.
5. Specialty clinics are not run.
6. Services like Hearing aid trials, Neonatal screening programmes, Speech & Voice analysis services are not available.
7. Register for Speech Therapy was not available for verification.
8. Equipment like Microdebrider for Sinus surgeries, Nerve Stimulator / Monitor, High definition digital camera with recording system, OAE, BERA are not available.
9. Investigative facilities like Nerve Conduction, EMG are not available.
10. CPC is not held.
11. The department does not participate in national programme for prevention & Control of Deafness.
12. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MS(ENT) course at Government Medical College, Miraj, Sangli, Maharashtra under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

9. **Starting of MD (Community Medicine) course at Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Sciences, Porompot, Imphal, Manipur under Manipur University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (06th September 2016) for Starting of MD (Community Medicine) course at Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Sciences, Porompot, Imphal, Manipur under Manipur University U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (06/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 2.
2. The column of Stipend paid by State Govt. to Residents & by institute to residents has been left blank.
3. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD (Community Medicine) course at Jawaharlal Nehru Institute of Medical Sciences, Porompot, Imphal, Manipur under Manipur University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

10. **Starting of MS (Obstetrics & Gynaecology) course at Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences, Maduranthagam, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.**

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (31st August 2016) for Starting of MS (Obstetrics & Gynaecology) course at Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences, Maduranthagam, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (31/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Parvatha Vardhini, Sr. Resident is not eligible, she has no 3 years experience as Jr. Resident in a medical college. There is no other Sr. Resident in Unit-I.
2. Labour Room is not air-conditioned.
3. On the day of assessment, total MRI in the entire hospital was 9, which indicates inadequate clinical material.
4. OPD attendance of Obstetrics on day of assessment was only 42. Average of randomly selected days is 45.
5. There were only NIL Major Obstetric & 2 Major Gynaec Operations on day of assessment. Average of randomly selected days is 1 Major Obstetric & 2 Major Gynaecological operations.
6. In the sub-column of "Stipend paid by Institute to Residents" at Item § 26 of Summary, it is stated "Not Applicable". There is no commitment on part of institute to pay stipend to Residents @ rates prescribed by State Govt.
7. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MS (Obstetrics & Gynaecology) course at Karpaga Vinayaga Institute of Medical Sciences, Maduranthagam, Tamilnadu under The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

11. Starting of MD (Emergency Medicine) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (7th September 2016) for Starting of MD(Emergency Medicine) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Professor Haider Abbas does not have 2 year special training in Emergency Medicine, prior to May 2016, he was working in his parent deparemnt in anaesthesia and not in Emergency Medicine.
2. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Assoc. Prof.: 1; (b) Asst. Prof.: 1.
3. Shortage of Residents: (a) Senior resident: 1; (b) Junior Resident: 1.
4. Bed Occupancy was 24 % on day of assessment.
5. There was no ECG machine in Emergency Department and there was no Endoscopy and Bronchoscopy equipment.
6. There are NIL dedicated beds for this department. The 30 beds shown are comprising of 24 beds of Disaster ward & 6 beds near casualty. Other space is shared with General medicine department.
7. Equipment for this department is not available separately.
8. Departmental library has only 10 books. NIL new books have been purchased during last 3 years.
9. CPC is not held.
10. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD(Emergency Medicine) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

12. Starting of MS (Traumatology & Surgery) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Only 2 medical faculty are available in the only Unit; hence faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit. Remaining faculty are drawn from various departments by rotation.
2. Two Asst. Prof. shown as faculty are having M.D.S. qualification; hence not eligible.
3. There is no Senior Resident.
4. All the faculty came by rotation from the Department of Surgery, Orthopaedics, Anaesthesia & Neuro-Surgery. There is no full time faculty in the department.
5. On the day of assessment bed occupancy in block –II was 50%.
6. Total 340 beds are shown for this department; but Unit-wise distribution is not shown. Only 2 medical faculty are available which is just adequate for 1 Unit for which 30 beds are permissible.
7. There is no separate OPD.
8. There was Nil MRI investigation on day of assessment in the department.
9. Equipment like Upper GI Endoscope, Bronchoscope are not available in the department.
10. Departmental Library has only 48 books.
11. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MS(Traumatology & Surgery) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

13. Starting of MD (Bio-Chemistry) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (07/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Dr. Abbas Ali Mahdi, Professor and HoD is non-medical. Dr. Shivani Pandey, Assoc.Prof. is also non-medical. Out of total faculty of 7, 5 faculty members are non-medical which is beyond the permissible limit.
2. Dr. Shivani Pandey has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 4 years as Asst. Prof. against requirement of 5 years as per Regulations; hence her promotion is not as per Regulations & she cannot be considered.
3. Clinical Biochemistry investigations are outsourced. Investigative workload of the Bio-Chemistry department is not given, column has been left blank. (Serial No.10 of the summery).
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for starting of MD(Bio-Chemistry) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

14. Starting of MD (Hospital Administration) course at King George Medical University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh under King Georges Medical University, Lucknow U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

1. Prof. Kirti Srivastava promoted on 03.08.2013 after the cut of date without any publications, which is not as per regulation.
2. Dr. Seema Gupta, Professor promoted on 08.03.2015 after the cut of date without any publications, which is not as per regulations. She was Asst. Prof. for 4 years and 8 months against the requirement of 5 years and Assoc. Prof. for 3 years against the requirement of 4 years.
3. Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Assoc.Prof. promoted on 07.03.2015 after the cut of date without any publication, which is not as per regulations. (Attention instruction sr.No.2 page 1)
4. Dr. N.K.Painuly, Professor, Dr. Teerthraj Verma, Dr. Shradhha Srivastava are M.Sc. Medical Physics which is not recognized qualification in Radio-therapy).
5. Unit wise distribution of staff not provided.
6. Faculty table is not signed by any of the faculty members and column of publications has been left blank.
7. Total number of Radiotherapy cases decreased from 2,286 to 2,211 during preceding 3 year period.
8. Total number of Brachytherapy cases decreased from 783 to 356 during preceding 3 year period.
9. Total number of Chemotherapy cases decreased from 3,498 to 630 during preceding 3 year period.
10. Accommodation for Radioactive material is not available.
11. Equipment for Radio Surgery is not available.
12. Facilities for Preoperative Radiotherapy are not available.
13. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

2. There is no Sr. Resident in Unit-III, and Unit -III has 2 faculty and both of them were on leave of the day of assessment.
3. Dr. Surya Kant, Professor & HOD was absent on day of assessment.
4. Details of books purchased in last 3 years for Departmental Library are not provided.
5. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

Education Regulations, 2000. Accordingly, the Consent of Affiliation that has been submitted is for a course that does not exist in Regulations. Thus the necessary requirement of submitting valid Consent of Affiliation by the affiliating University with the application is not fulfilled. In this regard, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgment dated 20.08.15 in Royal Medical Trust & Anr. Vs. Union of India & Anr. Reported in (2015) 10 SCC 19 has in paragraph 27 of the judgment laid down the mode and manner in which the application for establishment of new medical college, renewal of permission of existing and increase in intake capacity has to be processed, at all stages. It reads as under:-

27...

The Schedule giving various stages and time limits must accommodate very possible eventuality and at the same time must comply with the requirements of observance of natural justice at various levels. In our view the Schedule must ideally take care of:

“(A) Initial assessment of the application at the first level should comprise of checking necessary requirements such as essentiality certificate, consent of affiliation and physical features like land and hospital requirement. If an applicant fails to fulfill these requirements, the application on the face of it, would be incomplete and be rejected. Those who fulfill the basic requirements would be considered at the next stage”

Therefore, it would be appropriate to recommend to the Central Government to disapprove the application for starting/increase of seats in Pulmonary Medicine course as there is no such course existing in the regulations as on date”

68. Increase of seats in MS (Orthopaedics) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Maharashtra under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (9th September 2016) for Increase of seats in MS (Orthopaedics) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Maharashtra under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (09/09/2016) and noted the following:-

1. 6 faculty namely Dr. Nishant Gaonkar, Dr. Santosh Takale, Dr. Jineshwar Kapale, Dr. Sandip Patel, Dr. Vikas A S & Dr. C V Mahajan came late and signed for 7 days on the day of assessment, which is not acceptable.
2. There were only 2 Major Operations on day of assessment.
3. Details of Minor Operations, Casualty attendance are not available for day of assessment as well as for 3 randomly selected days.
4. Equipment like Hip Arthroplasty set & Knee Arthroplasty set are nonfunctional.

5. Only 3 Specialty clinics are run in OPD.
6. Casualty: There is no Triage area. Duty room is not available.
7. Publication, laboratory investigations, number of major operation,, minor operation, bed occupancy in the entire hospital on the day of assessment has not been provided.
8. Details of Radiological investigations, number of major and minor operations and bed occupancy in entire hospital not provided (column left blank).
9. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MS (Orthopaedics) course at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Maharashtra under Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences University (Deemed), Karad u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Note: The Postgraduate Committee decided to summon the Dean and seek his clarification for the above deficiency mentioned at Serial No.1.

69. Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (31st August 2016) for Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (31/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. Deficiency of faculty: (a) Asst. Prof.: 2.
2. Unit D at MG Hospital & Unit D at MDM Hospital have only 2 faculty each; hence faculty complement is incomplete & they cannot be considered as PG Units.
3. Unit A at MG Hospital which is the Unit of Dr. Manoj Lakhotia, Professor & HOD does not have any Asso. Prof.; hence faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
4. Dr. Sandeep Tank has been promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
5. Dr. N.S. Rawat is shown as "Professor" in the column of "Designation" in the faculty table; however in the column of "Experience", it is shown as Asso. Prof. from 02/06/2011 to 05/05/2016 & continue; he has no experience as Asst. Prof. and shown Assoc. Professor from 11.04.2005. Further, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
6. Dr. R.K. Bhimwal is shown as "Professor" in the column of "Designation" in the faculty table; however in the column of "Experience", it is shown as Asso. Prof. from 27/04/2012 till date; This discrepancy needs to be clarified. Further, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.

7. Dr. Naveen Kishoria is promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
8. Dr. Namit Mathur, Senior Resident does not have any experience as Resident before appointment as Senior Resident; hence not qualified to hold the post.
9. Equipment like Colonoscope, Bronchoscope, Holter are not available.
10. Details of beds occupied in ICCU & MICU on day of assessment are not provided.
11. Specialty clinics like Endocrinology clinic, Haematology clinic are not run.
12. Details of books purchased for Departmental Library during last 3 years are not provided.
13. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

70. Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

Read: the Council Assessor's Report (31st August 2016) for Increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences U/s 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (31/08/2016) and noted the following:-

1. There is no faculty in Unit-E. Hence, it cannot be considered a Unit.
2. The institute is permitted for MBBS annual intake of 250 seats for which 8 Units are required; however only 6 Units are available resulting in deficiency of 2 Units.
3. Six Units between them have 261 beds; however maximum 240 beds are permissible for 6 Units. It is not clarified who are managing these excess 21 beds.
4. Unit G at Paota has only 2 faculty; hence faculty complement is incomplete & it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
5. Dr. R.K. Saran is promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
6. Dr. Saitan Singh Rathore is promoted as Professor with experience of only 4 y against requirement of 5 y; however, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
7. Dr. Latika Sharma is promoted as Professor after cut-off date; however, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 4; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.
8. Dr. Bharati Saraswat is promoted as Asso. Prof. after cut-off date; however, the column of "Benefit of publications" in the faculty table has

been left blank implying NIL publications against requirement of 2; hence his promotion is not as per Regulations & he cannot be considered.

9. Specialty clinics like Urology clinic, Surgical gastroenterology clinic, Neurosurgery clinic, Paediatric Surgery clinic, Surgical Oncology clinic are not run.
10. Details of beds occupied in SICU on day of assessment are not provided.
11. NIL new books have been purchased for Departmental Library during last 3 years.
12. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Postgraduate Medical Education Committee decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue letter of permission for increase of seats in MS (General Surgery) course at Dr S N Medical College, Jodhpur, Rajasthan under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2017-18.
